APPROVAL, RESERVOIR LAND LEASE AT INDIAN LAKE, LOGAN COUNTY, OHIO, FOR THE RIGHT TO OCCUPY AND USE FOR PUBLIC PARKWAY AND PRIVATE DOCKLANDINGS—HAZELLE M. FICHTHORN.

Dear Sir:—This is to aknowledge the receipt of a recent communication from the bureau of inland lakes and parks in the division of conservation in your department, submitting for my examination and approval a reservoir land lease in triplicate executed by the conservation commissioner under the authority of section 471, General Code, to one Hazelle M. Fichthorn of Bellefontaine, Ohio. By this lease, which is one for a stated term of fifteen years and which provides for an annual rental of one hundred dollars payable in semi-annual installments of fifty dollars each, there is leased and demised to the lessee therein named the right to occupy and use for public parkway and private docklandings that portion of the State Reservoir land lying between a certain line run on a contour two feet above the present waste-weir line of Indian Lake and the ordinary water line of said lake and lying immediately south of a 91-acre tract of land formerly owned by Dennis Denny, later by a Mr. Anderson and now known as Chippewa Park, and being a part of Virginia Military Survey No. 12276 in Stokes Township, Logan County, Ohio, and containing 16 acres, more or less.

Upon examination of this lease, I find that the same has been properly executed by the conservation commissioner and by Hazelle M. Fichthorn, the lessee therein named. Upon careful examination of the provisions of this lease and of the conditions and restrictions therein contained, I find that the same are in conformity with statutory provisions relating to leases of this kind. I am accordingly approving this lease as to legality and form as is evidenced by my approval endorsed upon the lease and upon the duplicate and triplicate copies thereof, all of which are herewith enclosed.
