APPROVAL, BONDS OF ROCKFORD VILLAGE SCHOOL DISTRICT,
\$40,000, FOR CONSTRUCTION OF NEW SCHOOL BUILDING.

Department of Industrial Relations, Industrial Commission of Ohio, Columbus, Ohio.

Re: Bonds of Rockford village school district, in the amount of \$40,000, for the construction of new school building, 1 bond payable in 20 installments of \$2,000 each.

GENTLEMEN:—I have examined the transcript of the proceedings of the board of education and other officers of Rockford village school district, relative to the above bond issue, and find the same regular and in conformity with the provisions of the General Code.

I am of the opinion that a bond for said issue with combined principal and interest coupons attached, drawn in accordance with the bond resolution authorizing the same and in compliance with the resolution of the industrial commission adopted under authority of section 1465-58a G. C. will, upon delivery, constitute a valid and binding obligation of said school district.

The board of education of Rockford village school district, in order to meet the requirements of the provisions of the Griswold Act, has, since the bonds were purchased by your commission, amended its bond resolution so that the bonds mature \$2,000 on the first of September of each of the years 1923 to 1932, both inclusive. Your resolution of purchase should be amended to conform to the changed provisions of the bond resolution.
