its face to be an emergency law necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, with the reasons for such necessity set forth in the act. As laws of that character are expressly exempted from the referendum, it is my judgment that in this case I should decline to take any action in aid of such a course, and I therefore decline to approve the synopsis submitted.
