Narrative:

On July 23, 2024, Ohio Bureau of Criminal Investigation (BCI) Special Agent (SA) Joe Goudy (Goudy) received the results of the analysis for Matrix evidence Item #48, a black Apple iPhone 12 Pro Max Model 2342 with International Mobile station Equipment Identity (IMEI) 350408487357007. The analysis was completed by BCI Cyber Crimes Certified Forensic Specialist (CFS) Clarice Cowgill. A copy of her forensic analysis report has been attached to this report. The data extracted from the devices was stored on a thumb drive in the BCI SIU case file as Reference Item H. SA Jesse Bynum (Bynum) was assigned to review the data obtained from the extraction.

The data extracted from the device was organized in a Cellebrite Reader Report. SA Bynum utilized Cellebrite Reader to view the data and noted the following:

The cellular telephone was locked with an unknown six-digit code. A partial file system extraction was performed which allowed limited information to be extracted from the cellular telephone.

The cellular telephone appeared to belong to Kendell Woodard as the Apple ID associated with the device was kendell.woodard@gmail.com and there were "selfie" style photos of Woodard. Also in the photos was a screenshot of a CashApp profile screen showing the user ID [REDACTED] with a username of Kendell Woodard.

The AT&T branded Subscriber Identity Module (SIM) card had a phone number of 1-502-7116-1118 associated with it.

Photos of narcotics were observed. Only a small number of the messages listed in the extraction contained data and they were only from Snapchat. There could have been additional messages on the telephone that were not able to be recovered. None of the messages in the days prior to the incident appeared to be related to the shooting incident. Based on the content of the messages observed, it appeared Woodard abused illicit drugs. No anti-law enforcement content was observed.

Videos for the “I AM” application were located indicating the application was likely on the telephone. The “I AM” application is self-described to “help rewire our brains, build self-esteem, and change negative thought patterns”.

Summary:

On May 9, 2024, Special Agent Joseph Goudy of the Ohio Bureau of Criminal Investigation (BCI) received warrant to search the below listed item. Said item was forwarded to the Cyber Crimes Unit in Richfield, Ohio for analysis. This item was to be extracted for evidence relating to Aggravated Murder, Obstructing Official Business, Felonious Assault, and Theft regarding the subject Kendall Woodward.

Submitted Items:

- 048 – Mobile Phone – Black Apple (CSU Item #44) recovered from driver's seat of subject vehicle

Details:

Item 48: Item 48 is an Apple manufactured mobile phone; model A2342 (iPhone 12 Pro Max) with the International Mobile station Equipment Identity (IMEI) 350408487357007. Item 48 has an advertised internal storage capacity of approximately 256 Gigabytes (GB) and is not capable of additional storage. Item 48 is locked with an unknown, 6-digit PIN code. A partial file system extraction was performed.

Item 48's SIM: Item 48's SIM is an AT&T branded Subscriber Identity Module (SIM) card; bearing the Integrated Circuit Card Identifier (ICCID) 89012804320156432832.

Findings:

Item 48: Attachment A contains a Cellebrite Reader report for contents extracted from Item 48. Also appended in Attachment A is an executable file for the software Cellebrite
