Ptl Weekly responded to him and I went towards Ptl Patton, who was standing next to a black male in the open field. As I approached I observed the male be motionless on the ground. His eyes appeared to have started to glaze over and his mouth open. His left arm was stretched out above his head and it appeared to have blood on it. I observed there to be a black handgun on his chest. Not knowing if there were an cleared the suspect vehicle to ensure there was nobody in it.

I responded to check on Deputy Ackerman. Upon doing so I observed him to have blood down the front of his vest and on his hands. I observed Deputy Ackerman to be bleeding from what appeared to be a gunshot wound to the left side of his jaw. Ptl Weekly advised it appeared he had been struck in the left shoulder and face. Deputy Ackerman was awake and alert, responding to me. Deputy Ackerman heard a voice over the radio ask how many suspects we were looking for to which he responded "just one". I requested an ambulance to responded to provide Deputy Ackerman with medical attention and advised him to sit down. Lt Butler from the ACSO arrived on scene and I advised him of the situation.

A perimeter was set. The scene and investigation was turned over to the ACSO.

Martin in cutting off the deputies uniform shirt. At this time the an EMT arrived and assessed Deputy Ackerman. I then assisted in escorting Deputy Ackerman to the ambulance. At this time I then returned to the scene where the suspect was located. I went to help watch the perimeter to keep anyone who was not allowed from entering the scene. I was later interviewed by BCI and informed them of the actions I took throughout the process of the scene.

We responded code three (lights and sirens).

We were traveling on 2nd St approaching Sugar St, when I observed Deputy Ackerman's overhead lights in the east/west alley. I told to Ptl. Weekly to stop, and I bailed out of the vehicle and ran to assist Deputy Ackerman. I ran between a residence and a garage and when I rounded the garage, I observed a flashlight near his cruiser. I yelled "police" letting him know we were there with him. I observed a black male wearing all black lying face up on the ground. The suspect was not moving and his eyes were opened and glazed over. The suspects' chest was not rising and it was clear he was deceased. The suspect's mouth was open and he was also covered in blood. I immediately observed a black semi-automatic pistol on his chest. Deputy Ackerman was asking for an officer to "check me" as Ptl. Torres was running up to me. I told him to aid Deputy Ackerman due to the suspect being deceased. I asked Deputy Ackerman if there was any outstanding suspect(s). I stood with the suspect and maintained control of the immediate crime scene, and I radioed to responded units to set a perimeter. Once ACSO supervisors arrived on scene we let them know what we did and they asked us to stay around to give a statement to B.C.I.

I helped maintain a perimeter until a B.C.I special agent talked to me about the incident.

On June 21, 2022 at approximately 0235 hrs while working patrol, Dep. Ackerman advised over the radio that he was attempting to stop a vehicle on Second St. A few seconds later he advised the vehicle was failing to stop. I proceeded toward Dep Ackerman. While enroute to him, Dep Ackerman advised the subject was north on Sugar St from 2nd St. turning into an alley headed westbound. A few seconds later over the radio you could hear Dep. Ackerman yelling at the subject to stop and show me your hands. He was heard saying this multiple times during the radio transmission. The next transmission Dep. Ackerman advised 227 shots fired I'm hit start 10-30 followed by not sure where I'm hit but think I'm hit in the face. Dep. Ackerman then advised the subject was down and gave his location again.

Upon my arrival on scene LPD Ptl. Patton and Ptl Weekly were standing standing over by a black male subject who was laying on the ground. Ptl Torrez and Ptl. Martin were tending to Dep. Ackerman by his marked unit. Ptl. Torrez approached me and advised the subject, later identified as Quincy Pritchett, was deceased and that Dep Ackerman appeared to have a gunshot wound to his jaw and possibly chest. I approached Dep. Ackerman who had blood coming from what appeared to be a hole in the jaw and was bleeding. We had him sit down until Medics arrived and began administering aid to Dep. Ackerman. They then escorted Dep. Ackerman to the ambulance. While they were administering aid I had LPD assist in securing the scene with tape. Chief Mohler was contacted about the incident. He advised to make sure the scene was secure and he would be in contact with the Detective bureau and BCI&I would be handling the case. The scene was then secured and all unnecessary personnel were moved to the outer perimeter of the crime scene. We then stood by until Detectives and BCI&I arrived and the scene was turned over to them.

On June 21, 2022 at approximately 0235 hrs while working patrol, Dep. Ackerman advised over the radio that he was attempting to stop a vehicle on Second St. A few seconds later he advised the vehicle was failing to stop. I proceeded toward Dep Ackerman. While enroute to him, Dep Ackerman advised the subject was north on Sugar St from 2nd St. turning into an alley headed westbound. A few seconds later over the radio you could hear Dep. Ackerman yelling at the subject to stop and show me your hands. He was heard saying this multiple times during the radio transmission. The next transmission Dep. Ackerman advised 227 shots fired I'm hit start 10-30 followed by not sure where I'm hit but think I'm hit in the face. Dep. Ackerman then advised the subject was down and gave his location again.

Upon my arrival on scene LPD Ptl. Patton and Ptl Weekly were standing standing over by a black male subject who was laying on the ground. Ptl Torrez and Ptl. Martin were tending to Dep. Ackerman by his marked unit. Ptl. Torrez approached me and advised the subject, later identified as Quincy Pritchett, was deceased and that Dep Ackerman appeared to have a gunshot wound to his jaw and possibly chest. I approached Dep. Ackerman who had blood coming from what appeared to be a hole in the jaw and was bleeding We had him sit down until Medics arrived and began administering aid to Dep. Ackerman. They then escorted Dep. Ackerman to the ambulance. While they were administering aid I had LPD assist in securing the scene with tape. Chief Mohler was contacted about the incident. He advised to make sure the scene was secure and he would be in contact with the Detective bureau and BCI&I would be handling the case. The scene was then secured and all unnecessary personnel were moved to the outer perimeter of the crime scene. We then stood by until Detectives and BCI&I arrived and the scene was turned over to them.
