Investigative Activity: Attempt to Locate Fired Projectile

Narrative:

On October 9, 2023, at about 1227 hours, Ohio Bureau of Criminal Investigation (BCI) Special Agent (SA) Chuck Moran (Moran) went to the incident scene and attempted to located a fired projectile in the ground.

Previously, on October 4, 2023, at 1352 hours, SA Moran received an email from Ohio State Highway Patrol (OSHP) Trooper Brian DePizzo (DePizzo) indicating that he went back to the incident scene and located a possible ballistic impact on the ground near the area where the incident occurred. Trooper DePizzo sent SA Moran four photographs of the area via text message. SA Moran uploaded the photographs to Evidence.com under this case number. SA Moran later downloaded the photographs, placed them in Matrix, and attached them to this report.

During SA Moran's attempt to locate the fired projectile on October 9, 2023, SA Moran took multiple photographs of the area using Axon Capture. SA Moran noted that the area was in the grass near a small ditch/ravine between 7498 Van Ness Avenue (to the east) and 7524 Van Ness Avenue (to the west).

SA Moran located the potential ballistic impact on the ground on top of the west side of the ditch/ravine near a small tree. SA Moran felt the area on the potential ballistic impact for the projectile, but did not locate a projectile. SA Moran dug a couple of inches into the ground and removed some of the dirt from the potential ballistic impact site. SA Moran did not locate a projectile.

The resident at 7498 Van Ness Avenue, Frank Cwynar (Cwynar), exited his residence and offered to use his metal detector to try to locate the projectile. Cwynar used the metal detector and SA Moran walked with him around the area where the potential ballistic impact was located. SA Moran was unable to locate the projectile.
