APPROVAL, CONTRACT OF STATE OF OHIO WITH THE ALLIS-CHALMERS MFG. COMPANY, MILWAUKEE, WISCONSIN, FOR DIRECT CONNECTED ENGINE AND GENERATOR, COMPLETE, WITH SWITCHBOARD INSTRUMENTS, FOR OHIO STATE PENITENTIARY, COLUMBUS, OHIO, AT A COST OF \$14,925.00.

DEAR SIR:—You have submitted to me for approval a contract (five copies) between the State of Ohio, acting by the Department of Public Welfare, and Allis-Chalmers Mfg. Company, of Milwaukee, Wisconsin. This contract is for direct connected engine and generator, complete, with switchboard instruments, for the Ohio State Penitentiary, Columbus, Ohio, of the Department of Public Welfare, as covered by the proposal of the party of the first part which proposal is made a part of the contract, and calls for an expenditure of fourteen thousand, nine hundred and twenty-five (\$14,925.00) dollars.
