**Narrative:**

On Tuesday, July 08, 2025, at 1806 hours, Ohio Bureau of Criminal Investigation (BCI) Special Agent (SA) Brady Curry (SA Curry) interviewed Megis County Sheriff's Office (MCSO) Lieutenant Tylun Campbell (Lt. Campbell) #5305 The interview took place at the scene. The interview was audio recorded.

SA Curry informed Lt. Campbell before the interview started that his statement was voluntary and he could stop speaking at any time; he agreed to speak.

Lt. Campbell was identified as being a police officer who witnessed and/or had some level of involvement in the July 8, 2025, officer-involved shooting which occurred around 33635 Haning Road, Albany, Ohio, Ohio. Reportedly, Lt. Campbell did not discharge a firearm during the course of the incident. The purpose of the interview was to obtain all relevant information about the incident known or observed by this officer.

Lt. Campbell stated his unit number is #5305. Lt. Campbell has been employed by the MCSO for about 7 years. He has been a police officer for a total of 8 years.

Lt. Campbell advised Detective Samantha Wiedmer (Det. Wiedmer) had been leading an investigation involving Child Sexual Abuse Material (CSAM) with Patrick McDaniel (Patrick) being the subject of the investigation. Lt. Campbell advised Patrick possessed numerous CSAM pictures and videos. Patrick was utilizing the application "Kik". Lt. Campbell advised probable cause was developed and Det. Wiedmer obtained a search warrant for Patrick's residence.

Lt. Campbell and other Detectives/Deputies executed the search warrant.

Det. Wiedmer began interviewing Patrick and later Lt. Campbell assisted with the interview. This interview took place in the front yard/driveway near where the cars were parked. Lt. Campbell advised Patrick confessed to possessing CSAM.

Lt. Campbell went inside and requested [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] to detain Patrick. Lt. Campbell then heard a struggle outside. Lt. Campbell ran outside and observed Patrick having a gun in his hand and attempting to put it to Patrick's head. [REDACTED] was trying to get the gun from Patrick. Lt. Campbell advised that during the struggle, the gun was being pointed at [REDACTED]. Lt. Campbell told [REDACTED] to disengage Patrick. Lt. Campbell advised [REDACTED] held the gun to Patrick's head. Lt. Campbell and others were giving verbal commands to put the gun down. Lt. Campbell stated at one time, Patrick put the gun down to his side and it was believed Patrick was going to put the gun down. Patrick then raised the gun up to his head and pulled the trigger. Patrick shot himself in the head. Patrick fell to the ground. Sergeant K.J. Tracy (Sgt. Tracy) grabbed and secured the gun.

After the gunshot, Lt. Campbell observed [REDACTED] having a seizure or some type of medical emergency. Lt. Campbell picked [REDACTED] up and took him to a patrol vehicle to render aid. Emergency Medical Technicians were requested to respond to the scene. [REDACTED] was transported by squad to O'Bleness Hospital in Athens, OH.

The interview concluded at approximately 1819 hours.
