APPROVAL—RESERVOIR LAND LEASE TO LAND IN LICK-ING COUNTY, OHIO—WILLIAM E. SAYRE, RAY H. SAYRE AND FRED L. SAYRE OF BUCKEYE LAKE, OHIO.

COLUMBUS, OHIO, October 16, 1936.

Hon. L. Wooddell, Commissioner, Conservation Division, Columbus,

DEAR SIR: You have submitted for my examination and approval a reservoir land lease in triplicate executed by you as Conservation Commissioner to William E. Sayre, Ray H. Sayre and Fred L. Sayre of Buckeye Lake, Ohio.

By this lease, which is one for a stated term of fifteen years and which provides for an annual rental of \$300.00, payable in semiannual installments of \$150.00 each, there is leased and demised to the lessees above named, the right to occupy and use for cottage site, docklanding and general business purposes, the inner slope and water front and the outer slope and borrow pits in the rear thereof, that is included in Embankment Lot No. 2, east of the waste gates at Buckeye Lake, in the Southeast Quarter of Section 14, Town 17, Range 18, Licking County, Ohio, as laid out by the Ohio Canal Commission on the north shore of said lake in the summer of 1905, and being the same ground that was leased to Wm. H. Sayre, by the State of Ohio by two leases dated October 11, 1904, and May 9, 1905, respectively, with the privilege of maintaining and operating the boathouse and repair shop now located in front of said lot. The lot above described has a frontage of one hundred and fifty feet, east and west, measured along the top of the outer slope of the reservoir embankment.

Upon examination of this lease, I find that the same has been properly executed by you as Conservation Commissioner acting on behalf of the State of Ohio, and by William E. Sayre, Ray H. Sayre and Fred L. Sayre, the lessees therein named. Upon examination of the provisions of this lease and the conditions and restrictions therein contained, I find the same to be in conformity with the provisions of section 471 and of other sections of the General Code relating to leases of this kind.

I am, accordingly, approving this lease as to legality and form, as is evidenced by my approval endorsed upon the lease and upon the duplicate and triplicate copies thereof, all of which are herewith returned.
