On July 11, 2024, Ohio Bureau of Criminal Investigation (BCI) Special Agent (SA) Cory Momchilov (Momchilov) requested the following items related to ██████████ ██████████ ██████████) from Geauga County Sheriff's Office Lieutenant Jim Jonovich (Lieutenant Jonovich):

- OPOTA Certification records and/or any other training records
- Firearm qualification records
- Personnel Files (including any disciplinary or internal affairs records for previous incidents) but excluding copies of any internal affairs investigation or Garrity Statements relative to the current incident under investigation.

On August 16, 2024, SA Momchilov received a ONEDRIVE link from Geauga County Sheriff's Office records clerk Diane Peterson. The ONEDRIVE link contained ██████████ ██████████'s Training and Personnel File.

SA Momchilov reviewed the personnel file and noted the following:

██████████ completed his Ohio Peace Officer Basic Training Program at Kent State University, graduating on ██████████. ██████████ was employed part time by the Chardon Police Department from ██████████, until ██████████.

██████████ was hired full time on ██████████, by the Geauga County Sheriff's Office.

██████████ attended Basic SWAT Training on October 6-10, 2014.

██████████ has also attended numerous tactical training courses.

SA Momchilov could not locate any discipline in ██████████'s file.
