

Range 18, Fairfield County, Ohio, with the right to use for walkway purposes, only, the berme embankment of Buckeye Lake adjacent to said lots, being a strip of ground 16 feet in width back of the retaining wall, as now located along the top water line of the reservoir in front of said lots.

Upon examination of this lease, I find that the same has been properly executed by you as Conservation Commissioner, acting on behalf of the State of Ohio, and by Merrill L. Bigelow, the lessee therein named. Upon examination of the provisions of this lease and the conditions and restrictions therein contained, I find the same to be in conformity with the provisions of section 471 and of other sections of the General Code relating to leases of this kind.

I am, accordingly, approving this lease as to legality and form, as is evidenced by my approval endorsed upon the lease and upon the duplicate and triplicate copies thereof, all of which are herewith returned.
