BWC footage started at approximately 19:53:28 hours. At that time, was working a temporary assignment with the Safe Streets program with duty hours of Noon – 20:00 hours and his regular assignment was 2B12. At 19:54:58 hours, Dispatch can be heard advising "County was taking gunfire currently. 3110 E. Livingston". We was enabled the emergency equipment on his cruiser and used his cruiser radio to advise he was responding to the incident. While was responding to the scene, there was radio traffic stating "Male White, black shirt, tan pants" and that followed by additional communications including "suspect". At 19:56:59 hours, Dispatch can be heard advising "Be advised, County has officer down".

Livingston Avenue just east of 3110 (*See Photo* $BWC 1^{"}$). After exiting his cruiser, **busices** and be heard saying "What do you need, **busices** $BWC 1^{"}$). After exiting his cruiser, **busices** who is positioned behind a cruiser parked on the sidewalk/grass in front of 3110 (*See Photo* $BWC 2^{"}$). **busices and drove towards the rear of 3110** and parked in the parking lot near the northeast corner of the building (*See Photo* BWC

3"). **Solution** and the rear entrance door to 3110 and encountered an African-American male, later identified as building maintenance, standing at the northwest corner of the building (*See Photo* **BWC** 4").

the stairwell towards the third floor. Before reaching the third floor, the officers turned and headed down the stairs and at 19:58:38 hours, a gunshot can be heard followed by uttering "Oh shit. Where they at... where they at?". In the encountered three officers headed up the stairs from the Lower Level. Those officers told in the encountered three thought he had shot. In the interval then used his radio and advised "We need a location on County". In the made his way up the stairs and encountered an open door to the hallway

of the third level. **See Photo** encountered asked "Where's that coming from?" and someone replied "Out front" (*See Photo* **BWC** 5"). **Example** turned and ran down the stairs and exited the building.

parked in the street in front of 3110 (See Photo BWC 6"). CPD Cruiser 9090 is observed driving onto the grass in front of 3110 and at 19:59:46 hours, and meets up with the driver of Cruiser 9090 (See Photo BWC 7"). The officers can be heard trying to determine who, if anyone, fired the gunshot. There is radio traffic advising "County guy is advising they exchanged gunfire in front of that building...towards Livingston Avenue". Cruiser 9090 traveled through the front yard westbound towards BWC 8"). Cruiser 9090 drove along the westside of 3110 and parked near the northwest corner of the building (See Photo BWC 9").

can be heard advising "They are in the building". At 20:00:44 hours, CPD Sergeant Jonathon Goodrich (Sgt. Goodrich) can be heard advising "Did you guys hear that? County guy's ("inaudible") up there". Officers approach the rear door to 3110, open the door, and announce "Columbus Police". Sergeant Jonathon and CPD Sergeant Jonathon go down the stairs and serge cleared what looks to be a laundry room. Then opened the closed door and entered the lower hallway. As serge pened

the hallway door he announced "Columbus Police" (*See Photo 10" BWC 10*"). AT 20:01:36 hours, **based** can be heard saying "Let me see your hands... get your hands up" and Lindsey is visible in the doorway at the end of the hallway (*See Photo 10" BWC 11*"). AT 20:01:46 hours, **based** announced "Got a gun... got a gun". Officers retreated away from Lindsey while issuing commands such as "Hands up" and Columbus Police. Put your hands up" numerous times. At 20:02:05 hours, Lindsey is observed stepping inside the doorway with his right leg (*See Photo 1000 BWC 12*") and **based 10**". Lindsey turned towards the front of the building leaving only his back visible to the officers in the lower hallway. Officers advanced towards Lindsey and officers at the front of the building can be heard yelling commands at Lindsey.

AT 20:02:25 hours, Officer is the lower hallway take a kneeling position with their pistols fixed on Lindsey (*See Photo BWC 13"*). **But a second** can be heard using his radio to tell officer located at the front of the building to stay on the second level. Officers can be heard yelling "Let me see your hands" at Lindsey as well as "Don't you fucking grab that gun" and "Get your fucking hands up". **But a second** again advised the officers at the front to get away from the Lindsey and to back up. **But a second** can be heard telling the other officers the position

of the officers at the front of the building.



hallway

Sgt. Goodrich approached the officers kneeling in the hallway and advised "Nobody stand up if anything happens... you understand? Everybody stay down". At 20:03:20, an officer at the south end of the building can be heard yelling "Going Taser" followed by additional communication about a Taser, but that was covered by radio traffic from one of the officers in the lower hallway. At 20:03:23 hours, a "popping" sound is heard that is consistent with a Taser being deployed and Lindsey is seen stepping or falling into the hallway towards the officers positioned in the lower hallway. At 20:03:23 hours, a "popping" discharges his pistol at Lindsey and that is followed by additional officers discharging their pistols at Lindsey (*See Photo* BWC 14"). At 20:03:28 hours, an officer can be heard announcing "Cease Fire" and advised "Shots fired" on his radio. Officers start advancing towards Lindsey who had fallen to the ground. While advancing towards Lindsey, Officers can be heard announcing "Blue... Blue... Blue".

When officers reach Lindsey, **Section** is observed checking a blue/black and yellow jacket located at Lindsey's feet (*See Photo* **BWC** 15"). At 20:03:50 hours, an officer can be heard saying "The gun is right there... the gun is right there" and then the door opens and a black pistol is observed on the tile floor next to a white tennis shoe on the south side of the doorway (*See Photo* **BWC** 16"). **Section BWC** 16"). **Section Constant Const**

From the review of **Second** BWC footage, there was approximately two (2) minutes between the time officers first encountered Lindsey in the lower hallway and the time they discharged their pistols at him. During that time, officers can be heard issuing numerous commands to Lindsey regarding his hands and dropping a "weapon". Initially, Lindsey can be observed standing with his hands partially concealed by his body and the door. Officers positioned on the south end of the apartment can also be heard yelling similar commands at Lindsey. Three (3) seconds before CPD

Taser, Lindsey can be observed raising his right hand above his head and rested on the door. After the Taser is deployed (audible indication), it is unclear if Lindsey fell towards the officers in the lower hallway, or he intentionally moved towards them in attempt to avoid the Taser. That is when the officers in the lower hallway fired their pistols at Lindsey. It is unclear from the BWC footage how many times **Example of the set of th**
