APPROVAL—CONTRACT BY AND BETWEEN THE CONSOLIDATED SUPPLY COMPANY, DIVISION OF CENTRAL TABLET MANUFACTURING COMPANY, AND THE STATE OF OHIO FOR FURNISHING THE NECESSARY SEATING IN THE AUDITORIUM ADDITION AT BOWLING GREEN STATE UNIVERSITY.

DEAR SIR: You have submitted for my approval nine copies of a contract by and between the Consolidated Supply Company, Division of General Tablet Manufacturing Company, and the State of Ohio, acting by Carl G. Wahl, Director, Department of Public Works, for the furnishing of the necessary seating in the Addition to Auditorium for Bowling Green State University, Bowling Green, Ohio, as set forth in Item 1 Auditorium Seating, and Item 2 Seating Alternate "A", as set forth in the Form of Proposal dated May 20, 1937, all according to plans and specifications, which contract calls for the total expenditure of six thousand six hundred and sixty-nine dollars (\$6,669.00).

You have also submitted the estimate of cost, notice to bidders, proof of publication, the workmen's compensation certificate of the contractor, recommendation of the board of trustees of Bowling Green State University, the approval of the Public Works Administration, tabulation of bids, certificate of the Auditor of State that the plans and necessary papers are on file in that office, together with form of proposal properly executed by the contractor, contract bond signed by the American Surety Company of New York by the resident officers, the power of attorney of the signers of the surety, financial statement of the surety and the certificate of compliance showing the surety's right to transact business in the State of Ohio.

Finding said contract and bond in the proper legal form, I have this day noted my approval thereon and am returning the same herewith to you, together with pertinent papers submitted in this connection.
