Narrative:

On July 12, 2022, at approximately 2130 hours, Ohio Bureau of Criminal Investigation (BCI) Special Agent Perry Roeser responded to Miami Valley Hospital (MVH), Dayton, Ohio, regarding an Officer-Involved Critical Incident (OICI). SA Roeser was told a Clearcreek Township Police Officer, Eric Ney (Ney), was shot in the head by a man named Mark Evers (Evers). Clearcreek police officers were at the Evers property investigating a domestic violence call when Evers shot Ney. Ney’s partner shot and killed Evers during the exchange of gunfire. Ney’s partner was not injured when the gunfire stopped.

SA Roeser arrived at the hospital at approximately 2200 hours and met with nurse manager Shannon Ohl (Ohl) in the Emergency Department. [REDACTED]

SA Roeser then inquired about any property which the hospital potentially had. Ohl said all Ney’s belongings had been packed in paper bags and sealed. SA Roeser took custody of all the property from MVH Sgt. Anderson, see attachment #1, the chain of custody document.

SA Roeser arrived at the Evers property (Warren County) later in the evening and released all the packaged evidence to BCI Crime Scene Agent Chad Holcomb.
