PETITION — OLD AGE PENSIONS — AMENDMENT — OHIO CONSTITUTION—ADOPT ARTICLE XII, SECTION 13— GUARANTEE INCOME FIFTY DOLLARS PER MONTH, PERSON SIXTY YEARS OF AGE OR OVER ; FORTY DOLLARS PER MONTH TO EACH SPOUSE, WHERE MARRIED COUPLE LIVING TOGETHER.
