

Narrative:

On October 30, 2023, Ohio Bureau of Criminal Investigation (BCI) Special Agent (SA) Cory Momchilov requested that BCI SA Andrew Harasimchuk (Harasimchuk) conduct a Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco, Firearms and Explosives (ATF) eTrace on the following firearm; a Harrington and Richardson, Model 088, 12 gauge shotgun bearing a serial number of AY578110. This firearm was recovered at Howland Township, Ohio 44484, on the dining room floor and was reportedly used by Randall Fife.
