DEAR SIR:—The Bureau of Inland Lakes and Parks of the Division of Conservation in your department recently submitted for my examination and approval a reservoir land lease, in triplicate, executed by the Conservation Commissioner to one Leo Stander of Cincinnati, Ohio. This lease, which is one for a term of fifteen (15) years and which provides for an annual rental of six dollars (\$6.00), payable semi-annually, leases and demises to the lessee above named the right to occupy and use for docklanding and walkway purposes that portion of the State Reservoir land lying immediately in front of Lot No. 3, Waterbury's Allotment and formerly under lease to F. S. Waterbury as incorporated in lease No. 184; said allotment being located on the southerly shore of Indian Lake, Virginia Military Surveys Nos. 10121, 9946 and 9925, Washington Township, Logan County, Ohio.

Upon examination of this lease I find that the same has been properly executed by the Conservation Commissioner on behalf of the state of Ohio, and by Leo Stander, the lessee therein named. I further find upon examination of the provisions of this lease and of the conditions and restrictions therein contained, that the same are in conformity with the provisions of section 471, General Code, and with other statutory enactments relating to leases of this kind.
