**Narrative:**

On March 8, 2023, Ohio Bureau of Criminal Investigation (BCI) Special Agent James Poole (SA Poole) received a copy of the Circleville Fire Department (CFD) medical run report regarding a Pamela Croston (Croston). The medical run report was obtained via a verbal request with the CFD. These records are regarding the injuries of Croston as a result of an Officer-Involved Critical Incident which occurred on February 25, 2023. A copy of these records will be maintained electronically within the case file. Please refer to the records for specific details.

On March 21, 2023, SA Poole reviewed the CFD medical run report for Croston. The report states medics were called on 2/25/23 at 0157 hours, and arrived at 23897 US 23 HWY Circleville Oh 43113 at 0158 hours. The report reads, "EMS arrived 52 year old female found in lying supine position. Patient presents with multiple gun shot wounds. Respirations shallow rate 24. Left lung clear right lung diminished. Skin color pale/ashen. She was conscious and talking but was confused. Patient remained in stable condition during transport. Patient transported W/O incident or additional change in condition. Care transfer to ER staff." CFD Medics arrived at Grant medical center in Columbus, Ohio at 0231 Hours.

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

**Narrative**

UPON EMS ARRIVAL 52 YEAR OLD FEMALE FOUND IN LYING SUPINE POSITION. PATIENT PRESENTS WITH MULTIPLE GUN SHOT WOUNDS. HX OF N/A. RESPIRATIONS SHALLOW RATE 24. LEFT LUNG CLEAR RIGHT LUNG DIMINISHED. SKIN COLOR PALE/ASHEN - APPEARANCE NORMAL/DRY. INITIAL IMPRESSION MULTIPLE INJURIES. PERFORMED IO ADULT. ADMINISTERED LIDOCAINE AND OXYGEN. PT. ALLERGIES N/A. MEDIC 1 & ENGINE 1 WERE DISPATCHED ON A FEMALE WITH MULTIPLE GUNSHOT WOUNDS. ON ARRIVAL, CREW FOUND 52 YEAR OLD FEMALE LYING SUPINE ON THE SIDEWALK AT A MOTEL WITH LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICERS PRESENT. PATIENT HAD TOURNIQUETS APPLIED TO TO BOTH LEGS AS WELL AS HER LEFT ARM. SHE WAS CONSCIOUS AND TALKING BUT SEEMED CONFUSED. SHE HAD GSW'S TO HER RIGHT LEG ABOVE THE KNEE, LEFT LEG ABOVE THE KNEE, LEFT FOREARM, RIGHT ARMPIT AND ON THE BACK BETWEEN THE SHOULDER BLADES. CREW MOVED HER TO THE COT, LOADED HER INTO M1 AND PERFORMED DETAILED ASSESSMENT. THE RIGHT LEG WOUND WAS BLEEDING SO CREW APPLIED A SECOND TOURNIQUET AND TIGHTENED UNTIL BLEEDING STOPPED. CREW OBTAINED VITALS AS NOTED. RESPIRS WERE RAPID (44/MIN) RIGHT LUNG SOUNDS WERE DIMINISHED. CREW APPLIED O2 VIA NRM @15LPM. CREW ESTABLISHED IO ACCESS IN THE RIGHT HUMERAL HEAD WITH 45 MM NEEDLE AND ADMINISTERED 100MG LIDOCAINE, THEN FLUSHED WITH SALINE AND ADMINISTERED FLUID BOLUS. PATIENT REMAINED STABLE DURING TRANSPORT. AT ER, CREW MOVED PATIENT TO TRAUMA BAY, TRANSFERRED CARE AND GAVE REPORT TO TRAUMA TEAM. GRANT MEDICAL CENTER ADVISED NFO'S, PATIENT TRANSPORTED W/O INCIDENT OR ADDITIONAL CHANGE IN CONDITION. CARE TRANSFERRED TO ER STAFF
