DEAR SIR: You have requested my opinion on bond forms in connection with the provisions of Substitute House Bill No. 596, relative to live stock dealers or brokers and weightmaster's bonds.

I recommend the following bond forms to be used:

LIVESTOCK DEALER OR BROKER'S BOND

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS: That we.....

..... of..... as principal and..... of..... as surety, are held and firmly bound unto the State of Ohio, as obligee, in the penal sum of..... dollars (\$.....), for the payment of which we bind ourselves, our heirs, executors, administrators, successors and assigns, jointly and severally by these presents.

WHEREAS, the State of Ohio, by its Department of Agriculture, has appointed trustees for the custody of these bonds and

WHEREAS, said principal has applied for or has obtained a license to engage in business as a Dealer or Broker of livestock in the State of Ohio as prescribed under Section 1177-1, et seq., of the General Code of Ohio and any and all amendments thereto which may be lawfully made by the General Assembly of the State of Ohio, providing for the performance of all obligations involved and incurred in the license including prompt payment of proceeds for purchase or sale of livestock,

NOW THEREFORE, the condition of this obligation is that if the said principal shall perform all obligations involved and incurred in the license, including prompt payment of proceeds for purchase or sale of livestock, then this obligation shall be void otherwise to remain in full force and effect.

This bond may be cancelled or terminated by any party hereto by causing written notice to be served upon the other parties of the cancellation or termination, not less than ten (10) days prior to the effective date of such cancellation or termination.
