DEAR SIR:—You have submitted for my examination and opinion a proposed lease between the Ohio State Savings Association as lessor, and the State of Ohio acting through and by its Department of Public Works, for the Ohio State Medical Board, as lessee, by the terms of which it is proposed to lease certain rooms designed as "Suite 202-3-4- and 5 in the building known as the Ohio State Savings Building, Columbus, Ohio, for the use of the Ohio State Medical Board. The term of the lease is from the first day of February, 1928, to the first day of February, 1930, and the lease calls for a rental of \$250.00 per month, payable in advance, on the first day of each month.

You have also submitted a statement from the secretary of the Emergency Board to the effect that on the 5th day of January, 1928, said board allowed the sum of \$3,000 for the purpose of paying rent for the year 1928 and the charges incidental to the moving of the offices of said board.

There is also submitted a copy of the proceedings of the board of directors certified to by its president, authorizing the president and secretary of the lessor company to enter into the lease herein considered.

Finding said proposed lease in proper legal form, I hereby approve the same, and am returning the same to you herewith together with all other papers submitted in this connection.
