Narrative:

On Wednesday, November 20, 2024, Ohio Bureau of Criminal Investigation (BCI) Special Agent (SA) Jon Lieber (Lieber) received a "Firearms Trace Summary" report from the Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco, Firearms and Explosives (ATF). The report contained information about the firearm that David Septer possessed during the incident on October 5, 2024. The report provided details about the "Chinese," model SKS, serial number 1736836, including [REDACTED]
