#### Narrative:

On June 27, 2024, Ohio Bureau of Criminal Investigation (BCI) Special Agent (SA) Jesse Bynum (Bynum) received the Ohio BCI Laboratory report for items of evidence submitted on May 9, 2024, and May 17, 2024. The laboratory case number for the analysis is 24-33459. The report originated from the Firearms Section of the Laboratory and was authored by Forensic Scientist Michael Roberts. The report was dated June 11, 2024.

#### Conclusion:

Woodard's pistol (.38 Cal Revolver - Lab Item 20) was found to be operable. The projectile (Lab Item 47) removed from the right parasagittal skull and brain of Kendell Woodard was inconclusive when compared to the revolver. The projectile did not match the pistol's used by the Deputy or Troopers involved. Woodard was observed with a pistol in his right hand while in the truck. A .38 Cal Revolver (Lab Item 20) was recovered from Woodard's right hand after the incident and it had one fired casing and four unfired casings in the cylinder.

rcso spistol (Lab Item 39) was found to be operable. spistol was conclusively linked to eight cartridge casings (9mm Luger - Lab Items 1,2,5-7,9,10, and 25) found at the scene and six projectiles (9mm Luger - Lab Items 8, 13, 19, 29, 30, and 45) found in the roadway and inside of Woodard's truck. Specifically, Lab Items 8, 13, 19, 29, and 30 were found in the roadway and Lab Item 45 was found in the rear of cab stuck in rear driver's side seat back of Woodard's truck.

s pistol (Lab Item 40) was found to be operable.

s pistol was conclusively linked to seven cartridge casings (9mm Luger - Lab Items 3, 4, 18, 24, and 26-28) found at the scene, one fired bullet jacket (Lab Item 43) found at the scene, and three projectiles (Lab Items 48, 50, and 51) from Woodard's body. Specifically, lab item 43 was found in the front passenger seat of Woodard's vehicle, lab item 48 was removed from the right inferior, posterior parietal of Kendell Woodard, lab item 50 was removed from the paramedian left anterior neck of Kendell Woodard, and lab item 51 was removed from the left flank of Kendell Woodard.

OSHP spistol (Lab Item 41) was found to be operable. spistol was conclusively linked to five cartridge casings (9mm Luger - Lab Items 33-38) found at the scene and two projectiles (Lab Items 22 and 49) from the roadway and Woodard's body. Specifically, lab item 22 was found in the roadway and lab item 49 was removed from the vertex skull, midline of Kendell Woodard.

oshp s pistol (Lab Item 42) was found to be operable. s pistol was conclusively linked to seven cartridge casings (9mm Luger - Lab Items 11, 12, 14-17, and 23) found at the scene and one projectile (Lab Item 46) from the driver's side seat back of Woodard's truck.

#### Remarks

Item #31 was examined and found to be an unknown metal object; therefore, no further conclusions could be made.

Item #32 was examined and found it to be a rock; therefore, no further conclusions could be made.

Microscopic examination of the lead projectile, Item 44, revealed it to be consistent with being a lead bullet core and was found to be unsuitable for comparison purposes due to its' damaged condition and lack of sufficient detail.

The submitted fired 38 Special cartridge case in Item #21 was not examined.

There were no pertinent findings regarding the two (2) extra magazines in Item #40.

The glass type material in Item #43 was not examined.

Two (2) submitted cartridges from Item #21 and two (2) BCI supplied cartridges were used for testing.

Four (4) submitted cartridges from each of Items #39-42 were used for testing.

All evidence will be returned to the submitting agency.
