Narrative:

On Monday, December 19, 2022, Ohio Bureau of Criminal Investigation (BCI) Special Agent (SA) Lehnhart (Lehnhart) received training records from Knox County Sheriff's Office (KCSO) Sheriff David Shaffer for Deputy Michael Collins (Collins). 
