**Narrative:**

On Monday, December 19, 2022, Ohio Bureau of Criminal Investigation (BCI) Special Agent (SA) Lehnhart (Lehnhart) received training records from Knox County Sheriff’s Office (KCSO) Sheriff David Shaffer for Deputy Michael Collins (Collins). SA Lehnhart reviewed the training records and noted the following:

The POLARIS system utilized by OPOTA/OPOTC indicated the following:

Deputy Collins attended the Delaware Area Career Center and completed the Ohio Peace Officer Basic Training Program on Wednesday, December 6, 2017. His class was designated as BAS15-079.
