## Narrative:

On May 16, 2024, the Ohio Bureau of Criminal Investigation (BCI) was requested to perform an independent investigation on the facts and circumstances surrounding an Officer Involved Critical Incident which occurred in the area of 6382 Georges Creek Drive, Columbus, OH. During the incident, Rafael Warfield (Warfield) was shot and killed.

Around 0830 hours, Agents gave a next of kin notification to Warfield's sister, Artesha McBride. Agents had received information that both of Warfield's parents were deceased.

While on scene, agents were made aware of a male, Ralph Warfield (Ralph), had showed up on scene and was claiming to be Warfield's father. Agents confirmed that Ralph was indeed Warfield's father. At 1012 hours, SA Chad Holcomb and SA Jim Mulford gave a next of kin notification to Warfield's father, Ralph.

SA Holcomb told Ralph that Columbus Police responded to the scene of an altercation, shots were fired and Warfield is deceased.

Agents explained the process of the investigation.

The interview concluded at approximately 1017 hours.
