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Sir:

On Thursday, June 2, 2022 while at my private residence, I received a FIT call up at 1802 hours. I contacted my immediate supervisor, Sgt. Rini #9051, to acknowledge that the call up had been received. I learned from Sgt. Rini that I was to respond to University Hospital Emergency Room for processing of an injured CMHA Police Office. I arrived at University Hospital at 1937 hours and met with Homicide Unit Det. Borden #43. I learned that the Officer had suffered injuries during this incident and I learned the preliminary extent of his injuries. Below are the results of this scene process.




Scene: This is an indoor scene consisting of Room #34 in the University Hospital Emergency Department.

Photos: CS# 177718+B, 69 photos were taken P.O. [redacted] seated in a reclined position in a hospital bed noting the hospital room number. Photos show [redacted] wearing black duty boots, blue uniform pants with suspected blood and a gray t-shirt. Photos show an IV in [redacted] right forearm, a blood pressure cuff on his right bicep, an oxygen sensor on his right index finger and a hospital identification band on his right wrist. Photos show [redacted] right forearm bandaged due to hospital treatment and his left index finger bandaged. Photos show the backs and palms of [redacted] hands. Photos of [redacted] injuries are as follows.

- Cuts above the left eye.
- Scratches on the left check.
- Cut and swelling on the left side of the upper lip.

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- Scratches around the right eye.
- A bandaged left index finger reported to have the tip bitten off. The bandage was not removed for photos as not to cause further and unnecessary injuries to this finger.

Photos show [REDACTED] uniform shirt with suspected blood, duty belt with OC spray, belt keepers and radio holder. Photos show [REDACTED] CMHA Police Identification Card and Police Badge. Photos show [REDACTED] body armor. Photos show [REDACTED] black duty gloves that were torn and with suspected blood. Photos show the tip of [REDACTED] left index finger inside of the tip of the left hand glove index finger. Photos show the tip of [REDACTED] finger after being recovered from the glove by Det. Strick and before being taken by medical staff.

Prints: No latent prints were requested.




1. 1 CHMA patched Police uniform shirt with suspected blood. (114/9) The CMHA Police Badge was removed from this uniform shirt and released to [REDACTED]
2. 1 pair of blue uniform pants and belt with suspected blood. (114/10)
3. 1 pair of torn black work gloves with suspected blood. (114/11)

Summary: On June 2, 2022, I responded to University Hospital located at 11100 Euclid Ave. for a +B crime scene process. I met and conferred with Homicide Det. Borden and this scene was processed as documented above. LERMS entries have been completed.
