DEAR SIR:—You have submitted for my approval a certain lease as hereinafter set forth, granting to you, as Superintendent of Public Works for the use of the Senate Investigating Committee on the Department of Industrial Relations, certain office rooms in Columbus, Ohio, as follows:

Lease from the Capitol Outlook Building Company, acting by one H. S. Gump, as agent, for suite No. 417 in the Outlook Building, 44 East Broad Street, Columbus, Ohio. This lease is for a term of two months beginning on the seventeenth day of February, 1931, and ending on the sixteenth day of April, 1931, by the terms of which the State will be required to pay sixty-five dollars (\$65.00) per month.

There has been submitted an encumbrance estimate which contains the certificate of the Director of Finance, to the effect that funds are available for the payment of said rentals.

A certificate is filed showing that H. S. Gump, building manager, has authority to sign the lease on behalf of the Capitol Outlook Building Company.
