Narrative:

On July 12, 2023, Ohio Bureau of Criminal Identification and Investigation (BCI) Special Agents Ryan Scheiderer and Kyle Douglass (SA Scheiderer and SA Douglass) went to the area of 3110 E. Livingston Avenue in attempt to locate any video evidence of the July 8th shooting incident between Antwan Lindsey (Lindsey) and law enforcement officers from the Columbus Division of Police (CPD) and the Franklin County Sheriff's Office (FCSO). Lindsey was fatally shot by officers during that incident.

3090 E. Livingston Avenue (Rental Office for 3110 E. Livingston Avenue)

- Spoke with Maintenance Manager James E. Saunders ([REDACTED])
 - 3110 E. Livingston Avenue– none of the cameras record due to residents tampering with them
 - 3090 E. Livingston – cameras work and should have recorded something. Saunders will arrange with corporate for video to be picked up by SA Douglass

3015 E. Livingston Avenue (Walgreens)

- Spoke with Store Manager Kevin Fallin ([REDACTED])
 - Fallin provided DVD with recording of Steven Nida entering store and approaching [REDACTED] [REDACTED].
 - Later found DVD didn't contain any recordings. SA Douglass will make contact with Fallin to get recordings
