On Wednesday, September 25, 2024, Ohio Bureau of Criminal Investigation (BCI) Special Agent (SA) Eric Lehnhart (SA Lehnhart) received Maureen Stopperich's (Stopperich) emergency medical services (EMS) response records from Detective Sergeant Sharon Cole of the Youngstown Police Department.
