APPROVAL—GRANTS OF EASEMENT, STATE OF OHIO. THROUGH CONSERVATION COMMISSIONER, 4 TRACTS OF LAND, NUMBERED AND DESIGNATED, IN FITCHVILLE, CLARKSFIELD, WAKEMAN AND GREENWICH TOWNSHIPS, HURON COUNTY, OHIO, FOR PUBLIC FISHING GROUNDS AND TO IMPROVE THE WATERS AND WATER COURSES PASSING THROUGH AND OVER SAID LANDS.

DEAR SIR: You have submitted for my examination and approval certain grants of easement, executed to the State of Ohio by several property owners in Fitchville, Clarksfield, Wakeman and Greenwich Townships, Huron County, Ohio, conveying to the State of Ohio, for the purposes therein stated, certain tracts of land in said townships and county.

The grants of easement here in question, designated with respect to the number of the instrument and the name of the grantor, are as follows:

By the above grants there are conveyed to the State of Ohio, certain lands described therein, for the sole purpose of using said lands for public fishing grounds, and to that end to improve the waters or water courses passing through and over said lands.

Upon examination of the above instruments, I find that the same have been executed and acknowledged by the respective grantors in the manner provided by law and am accordingly approving the same as to legality and form, as is evidenced by my approval endorsed thereon, all of which are returned herewith.
