**Narrative:**

On Sunday, October 12, 2025, Ohio Bureau of Criminal Investigation (BCI) Special Agents Joe Lamping (SA Lamping) and Orlando Almonte (SA Almonte) conducted a neighborhood canvass in the area of 681 Fourth Street Southwest, Warren, Ohio. The purpose for the canvass was to identify and interview potential witnesses to the officer-involved critical incident (OICI) that occurred in the area of 681 Fourth Street Southwest, Warren, Ohio on Sunday, October 12, 2025.

**Contacted Residences**

Special Agents Lamping and Almonte went to any residence which was situated in a location where an occupant may have observed any portion of the OICI. An assortment of residents stated that they heard the sirens from the police vehicles, and some stated that they heard gunshots, but only two individuals, Angel Greathouse and Britney Spencer, reported observing any portion of the OICI directly. ### 660 Fourth Street Southwest: Angel Greathouse

While conducting the neighborhood canvas, Special Agents Lamping and Almonte noticed a bullet defect in the covered porch flashing of 660 Fourth Street Southwest. SA Lamping contacted the resident, who was identified as Angel Greathouse (Greathouse). He inquired if the bullet defect was new or preexisting. Greathouse stated that she was not certain but felt that it was new. She also stated that she observed a portion of the OICI and agreed to participate in a voluntary recorded interview.

The interview with Greathouse started at 1032 Hours and lasted for four minutes and twenty seconds. Angel was asked what she observed during the OICI and she stated the following:

*Um, I just looked out my front window to my bathroom and I just seen multiple cop cars, uh, aligned in front of this underground church with, uh, body on the ground already. I couldn't see any description of the body or anything. I just seen multiple people around them and I had known it was a gunshot 'cause that's what, you know, I had woken up to. So, I just seen them working on them and then the ambulance coming eventually and taking, taking them off. (0:27)*

Greathouse estimated that the incident occurred at 0700 hours. SA Lamping asked Greathouse if she recalled how many gunshots she heard and she stated:

*Um, honestly, I, I, heard like a loud bang, I'm not sure if that was a gunshot when I woke up because it just, it sounded like someone was breaking into my door or it or like, that's what it sounded like. And then I heard, I think maybe, maybe one, there wasn't very many shots. I think there was only like, maybe one. (1:04)*

SA Lamping pointed out the bullet defect in the porch flashing and asked Greathouse for consent to search the exterior of the residence for further defects. She granted BCI agents consent to do so and completed a written consent to search form. Greathouse also provided consent to examine her vehicle for bullet defects. BCI agents would later locate an additional bullet defect in the front porch siding.

The consent to search form completed by Greathouse was attached to this report where it can be reviewed in its entirety.

### 689 Fifth Street Southwest: Britney Spencer

Special Agents Lamping and Almonte made contact with Britney Spencer (Spencer) at her residence; 689 Fifth Street Southwest. Spencer advised us that she witnessed a portion of the OICI, and that her home surveillance cameras also captured some of the incident. Spencer agreed to provide a recorded statement.

The interview with Spencer was initiated at 1202 hours and lasted one minute and fifty-nine seconds. SA Lamping asked Spencer to describe what she saw. She explained that at about 0657 hours she heard police vehicles coming down the street. She went to her front door and observed the shooting. She stated that she heard about eight gunshots during the incident. Spencer walked the agents to the location she watched the shooting from. She was located at the northwest corner of her driveway. SA Lamping ended the recording and took several photos from Spencer's approximate vantage point to document what she may have been able to see. While taking the photos, SA Lamping asked Spencer if she was able to make out anything distinct at the shooting scene, and she stated that, aside from seeing muzzle flashes, she could not.

The below picture represents an approximate view the Spencer may have had during the incident, it should be noted that this photograph was taken in daylight conditions as opposed to the dark conditions that were present during the OICI:



A yellow highlight was added to the image to indicate an approximate area where the incident may have been visible to Spencer. Present in the yellow highlight was a BCI

crime scene vehicle. Additional photos, taken while looking East and West from Spencer's approximate perspective, are stored on Axon Justice.

Spencer also shared a Wyze home surveillance video with the agents. The video started at 06:57:22 hours. Brad Bailey's (Bailey) vehicle was observed driving by the residence, while being pursued by multiple police vehicles with emergency lights and sirens activated. At approximately 06:58:26 hours, Spencer is observed walking towards the end of her driveway. At approximately 06:58:30 a series of loud percussive sounds, consistent with gunshots, were heard on the video. The suspected gunshots ended at approximately 06:58:33. While the shots were being fired, Spencer made her way back towards her residence. A police car was parked in front of the residence, and the emergency lights made it very difficult to see past the street. It did not appear that any portion of the OICI was visible aside from the initial arrival of Bailey and officers on Fifth Street Southwest.

The interviews conducted with Greathouse and Spencer were audio recorded. The recordings were uploaded to Axon Justice and stored as part of Reference Item D - Witness Interviews where they can be reviewed in their entirety.
