Narrative:

On Thursday, May 19, 2022, the Bureau of Criminal Investigations (BCI) Special Investigation and Crime Scene Units were requested to respond to an Officer-Involved Critical Incident that occurred in the area of SR 339 near mile marker 3, Belpre, Ohio. Following a vehicle pursuit and traffic crash there was interaction between Washington County Sheriff's Office (WCSO) Deputy [REDACTED] (involved deputy) and Devon Taylor (involved party). It was learned Devon brandished a firearm and Deputy [REDACTED] discharged his firearm. Devon was pronounced deceased at the scene. It should be noted Devon's identity could not be confirmed on scene; therefore, no next of kin notification could be conducted on this date.

On Friday, May 20, 2022, following an autopsy, Special Agent Supervisor Kevin Barbeau was notified by Special Agent Shane Hanshaw that the deceased involved party was that of Devon. SAS Barbeau requested SA Jonathan Jenkins respond to addresses provided to attempt a next of kin notification with the parents of Devon.

At approximately 1648 hours SA Jenkins, with the assistance of WCSO, arrived at 206 Franklin St., Marietta, Ohio 45750. There he notified the biological parents, Tyra Taylor (Hall) and Jeremy Taylor, of Devon's passing. According to Tyra, Devon is addicted to Meth and he has been known to steal cars. Also, Tyra noted Devon was raised in foster care by Mona Anderson in Waterford, Ohio.
