APPROVAL—BOND FOR THE FAITHFUL PERFORMANCE OF  
HIS DUTIES AS RESIDENT DISTRICT DEPUTY DIREC-  
TOR—J. K. TERRY.

DEAR SIR You have submitted a bond in penal sum of Five Thousand Dollars (\$5,000.00), with sureties as hereinafter indicated, to cover the faithful performance of the duties of the official as hereinafter listed:

J. K. Terry, Resident District Deputy Director in Lucas, Fulton and Henry Counties—Fidelity and Deposit Company of Maryland.

The foregoing bond is undoubtedly executed pursuant to the provisions of Sections 1183 and 1182-3, General Code, which sections in so far as pertinent herein provide as follows:

“Sec. 1183. \* \* \* Such resident district deputy directors shall \* \* \* give bond in the sum of five thousand dollars. \* \* \*”

“Sec. 1182-3. \* \* \* All bonds hereinbefore provided for shall be conditioned upon the faithful discharge of the duties of their respective positions, and such bonds \* \* \* shall be approved as to the sufficiency of the sureties by the director (of highways), and as to legality and form by the attorney general, and be deposited with the secretary of state \* \* \*.” (Words in parenthesis the writer’s.)

Finding said bond to have been properly executed according to the above noted statutory provisions, I hereby approve same and am returning it to you herewith.
