Narrative:

On Monday, August 8, 2022, Special Agent (SA) Shane Hanshaw (Hanshaw) obtained a copy of a police report, follow-up summary, and audio recording collected by the Marietta Police Department (MPD). The report and accompanying documents give details regarding the investigation of a stolen vehicle.

The MPD report and Investigation is significant in that it gives the account of the stolen car driven by Devon Taylor during the Officer-Involved Critical Incident (OICI), and also indicates that Taylor was seen with a CO2 type pistol earlier in the evening.

On Thursday, May 19, 2022, MPD Patrolman (Ptl.) Ellenwood took a report of a stolen vehicle. The vehicle, a maroon Honda four-door with VIN of 1HGCR3F96FA034538, was reported as a stolen vehicle by Mahone Tire Service located at 155 Front Street in Marietta, Ohio. The vehicle is owned by Chris Ullman Preowned Cars located at 204 3rd St., Williamstown, WV 26187. The vehicle had been taken to Mahone Tire for new tires and was to be picked up at a later date. When an employee of Chris Ullman Preowned Cars called and asked if the car was ready, it was discovered that the car had been stolen.

On Monday, May 23, 2022, Ptl. Ellenwood spoke with Larry Goodwin, Jr. (Goodwin Jr.) at his residence located 307 Maple Street. Goodwin Jr. stated he last saw Taylor the evening on May 18, 2022. Goodwin Jr. said his old lady passed out in the house and he was playing video games. Goodwin Jr. said Taylor returned between 2:00 and 3:00 AM. Goodwin Jr. said when Taylor came back, he was in a car. Goodwin Jr. said Taylor came inside the house and told him he had a car. Goodwin Jr. said Taylor asked him if he could charge his phone. Goodwin Jr. said yes, but told Taylor he didn't want the car sitting around his house. Goodwin Jr. said he went back to playing his video games, and Taylor left.

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Goodwin Jr. said prior to leaving, Taylor had a gun and he was worried that Taylor might do something stupid. When asked, Goodwin Jr. described the gun as looking like a Beretta. Goodwin Jr. advised the gun was greenish tan in color, but was actually a BB gun which ran off of CO2 cartridges. When asked what time Taylor left his residence, Goodwin Jr. advised between 10:00 and 11:30 PM. on May 18, 2022. When asked if Goodwin Jr. saw the gun when Taylor stopped at his house the second time, Goodwin Jr, said he had.

On the above date and time, I Ptl. R.L. Ellenwood was dispatched to Mahone Tire located at 155 Front St. in reference to a stolen car. The car was brought to Mahone Tire to get new tires on it. The tires were put on and the keys were left over the visor and Parked on the northside parking lot for pickup. The business closed at 5pm. The car was still parked there after the business was close. The following morning the workers returned and the vehicle was gone. It was assumed that an employee of Chris Ullman preowned Cars located at 204 3rd St. Williamstown WV. 26187 had came and picked it up. Later this date, an employee of Chris Ullman Preowned cars called and asked if the car was ready. At this time, it was found that the car had been taken. The vehicle is being described as a Maroon 4-door Honda Accord with new tires. Vin number is1HGCR3F96FA034538. I received a written statement from Robert Miller form Mahone's about the car being stolen.

At this time, I remembered that a car was crashed out on SR339 that ended up as an officer involved shooting. I thought I would check with the Sheriff's office to make sure this was not the vehicle. I spoke with a dispatcher Andrea Gibeaut who confirmed this was indeed the car involved in the crash.

Next, I checked the area and found that Murray's Glass has pretty good surveillance video. I spoke with the owner Dennis Farrar who put me in touch with Alex Saliba with
