RE: Bonds of Sylvania village school district in the amount of \$6,000, being 6 bonds of \$1,000 each.

Gentlemen:—I have examined the transcript of the proceedings of the board of education and other officers relative to the above bond issue and am of the opinion that said bonds are not valid obligations of the school district and advise that you decline to accept them.

The transcript of proceedings indicates that the board of education in one proceeding has submitted to the electors three separate and distinct propositions, viz., to issue bonds under section 7625 G. C. to enlarge, erect and furnish an additional school house; to issue bonds under 5656 G. C. to refund outstanding indebtdness of the district, and under section 5649-5 G. C. to authorize the levying of taxes in excess of the limitations provided by sections 5649-2 and 5649-3 G. C.

The board of education undoubtedly was authorized to submit to the electors any one of the three propositions above stated and doubtless could issue bonds under the provisions of section 7625 G. C. in the amount of the issue under consideration.

I do not believe, however, that they are authorized to combine in one proceeding and submit to the electors upon one ballot all of the three separate and distinct propositions.

I therefore advise you not to purchase the bonds above described.
