DEAR SIR: You recently submitted for my examination and approval a canal land lease in triplicate executed by you as Superintendent of Public Works and as Director of said department to one Albert Rowe of Circleville, Ohio.

By this lease, which is one for a stated term of fifteen years and which provides for an annual rental of \$6.00, there is leased and demised to the lessee above named the right to occupy and use for residential and agricultural purposes that portion of the abandoned Ohio Canal property in the city of Circleville, Pickaway County, Ohio, said described as follows:

Beginning at the top of the outer slope of the towing-path embankment of said canal, same being at or near station 3293+00; thence easterly along the top of the outer slope of said towing-path embankment, four hundred twenty-three (423') feet, more or less, to a point opposite the northeast corner of a tract of land deeded to the State of Ohio by Valentine Keffer; thence across the canal with the east line of said lot, produced, seventy-five (75') feet, more or less, to

the northeast corner of the state lot; thence westerly along the north line of the state lot, four hundred twenty-five (425') feet, more or less; thence north sixty-eight (68') feet, more or less, to the place of beginning and containing seven-tenths (0.7) of an acre, more or less.
