DEAR SIR:—You have submitted for my approval a contract between the State of Ohio, acting by the Department of Public Works, for the Department of Public Welfare, and the Armstrong Cork and Insulation Company of Lancaster, Pennsylvania, and Cincinnati, Ohio. This contract covers the construction and completion of contract for Insulation for Ice Plant, Storeroom and Equipment, Dayton State Hospital, Dayton, Ohio, in accordance with the form of proposal dated May 23, 1932. Said contract calls for an expenditure of one thousand, three hundred and seventy-five dollars (\$1,375.00).

You have submitted the certificate of the Director of Finance to the effect that there are unencumbered balances legally appropriated in a sum sufficient to cover the obligations of the contract. You have also shown that the Controlling Board and Emergency Board have approved the expenditure in accordance with Section 8 of House Bill No. 624, of the 89th General Assembly. In addition, you have submitted a contract bond upon which the United States Fidelity and Guaranty Company appears as surety, sufficient to cover the amount of the contract.
