Dear Sheriff Frazier:

On today's date I interviewed [REDACTED] regarding his recent officer involved shooting incident. I was able to do the interview remotely via Zoom and was able to conduct a debriefing about the incident.

[REDACTED] is an experienced law enforcement officer and has reacted appropriately to the incident that led to the shooting of the suspect. He is not demonstrating any overt symptoms that would suggest that he is experiencing any post-traumatic effects of the incident; he sleeps normally, has a normal appetite, is not experiencing any flashback memories. He is able to discuss the incident without undue emotional reactivity.

It is my opinion that he is able to return to his duties with your office at this time, and I will follow up in a few days to insure that he continues to do well. He notes that he has been back to the office on a daily basis and that is helpful as well, as it allows ongoing support from his co-workers and others.
