EASEMENTS TO STATE—C. E. SLOUGH AND GEORGE SCHUL, DESIGNATED LAND, GRATIS TOWNSHIP, PREBLE COUNTY, PUBLIC FISHING GROUNDS.

DEAR SIR: You have submitted for my examination and approval two grants of easement, Nos. 2272 and 2273, executed to the State of Ohio by C. E. Slough and George Schul respectively, conveying to the State of Ohio, for the purposes therein stated, certain tracts of land in Gratis Township, Preble County, Ohio.

By the above grants there are conveyed to the State of Ohio, certain lands described therein, for the sole purpose of using said lands for public fishing grounds, and to that end to improve the waters or water courses passing through and over said lands.
