GENTLEMEN:—Receipt is acknowledged of your letter of November 4, 1925, submitting for my examination transcript, in duplicate, covering proceedings for the proposed sale to Edward W. Jones, of Nashport, Ohio, of a portion of the abandoned Ohio Canal in the village of Nashport, Muskingum county, Ohio.

The proposed sale is contemplated in conformity with the provisions of sections 13971 and 14203-23 of the General Code of Ohio, and of the act of March 6, 1913.
