APPROVAL—RESERVOIR LAND LEASES, STATE OF OHIO, THROUGH CONSERVATION COMMISSIONER, DESIGNATED LANDS, INDIAN LAKE, LOGAN COUNTY, OHIO, TO THREE LESSEES.

DEAR SIR: You have submitted for my examination and approval, a number of reservoir land leases executed by the State of Ohio, through you as Conservation Commissioner to the several lessees therein named, by which there were leased and demised to the respective lessees therein named a number of parcels of reservoir lands owned by the State at Indian Lake, Ohio.

These leases, designated as to the names of the several lessees, the locations of the parcels of land leased, and the annual rental provided for therein, are as follows:
