Narrative:

On Monday, May 13, 2024, Ohio Bureau of Criminal Investigation (BCI) Assistant Superintendent Mark Kollar (Kollar) received a "Firearms Trace Summary" report from the Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco, Firearms and Explosives (ATF). The report contained information about the firearm that De'Shawn Vaughn possessed during the incident on May 12, 2024. The report provided details about the Taurus, model G2C, serial number ACJ267311, [REDACTED]

Additionally, an FBI National Crime Information Center (NCIC) and Law Enforcement Automated Data Base (LEADS) check of the weapon was conducted by BCI Criminal Intelligence Unit (CIU) to determine if the weapon was reported as being stolen. CIU reported that the firearm came back with nothing on file.
