FEES—RECEIVED BY MARIETTA POLICE JUDGE AND OFFICER IN
STATE AND ORDINANCE CASES—PAID INTO MUNICIPAL TREAS-

SYLLABUS:

The fees of the police judge and police officer of the police court of the city of Marietta, which are assessed and collected by the clerk of the police court in state cases, as well as ordinance cases, are properly payable to the municipal treasury.

GENTLEMEN:—Acknowledgment is made of the receipt of your recent communication, which reads:

“Section 4270, General Code, governs the disposition of fines and other moneys coming into the hands of the mayor. The section does not control the disposition of fees in state cases (111 O. S., *State ex rel. vs. Nolte*, page 486).

The pertinent part of Section 14693-4, General Code, Section V of the Act establishing a police court in the city of Marietta, 113 O. L., p. 764, reads:
