On December 21, 2022, Ohio Bureau of Criminal Investigation (BCI) Special Agent (SA) Chad Holcomb was assigned to assist the Shelby Police Department (SPD) with an ongoing officer involved critical incident. It was reported that Todd Jordan (Jordan) went to the Sidney Foodtown with a firearm. Four Sidney Police Officers arrived at the convenience store and encountered Jordan (see report by SA Taylor). It was reported that Jordan brandished a firearm. The officers fired their weapons killing Jordan.

SA Holcomb arrived at the Sidney Police Department located at 234 West Court Street, Sidney, OH 45365 at 1028 hours. All officers were photographed as they were upon arrival. They were all dressed in their agency uniform with markings of being a law enforcement officer. The officers stated they all discharged agency issued rifles. Their handguns were documented through photography.
