APPROVAL — CONTRACT, STATE OF OHIO, THROUGH DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC WORKS, FOR BOARD OF TRUSTEES, MIAMI UNIVERSITY, OXFORD, OHIO, WITH FOSDICK AND HILMER, CONSULTING ENGINEERS, CINCINNATI, OHIO, FOR SERVICES, CONSTRUCTION WEST WING, CHEMISTRY BUILDING, HUGHES HALL, ENCUMBRANCE RECORD No. 1671, AMOUNT \$1,779.80.

DEAR SIR: You have submitted for my approval a contract by and between the State of Ohio, acting by Carl G. Wahl, Director of Public Works, for and on behalf of the Board of Trustees of Miami University, and Fosdick & Hilmer, Consulting Engineers, Cincinnati, Ohio, for the preparation of plans, specifications, bills of material and estimates of cost for the mechanical branches only for the construction of the West Wing to the Chemistry Building (Hughes Hall). His duty also to include the superintending of the construction of said improvement and the inspection of said materials going into said improvement previous to their incorporation into the same.

Incorporated into the contract is the approval by the Board of Trustees of Miami University, by its Building Committee. There is also submitted encumbrance record No. 1671 in the amount of \$1,779.80, and the release of the necessary funds by the Controlling Board.

Finding said contract in the proper legal form, I have this day noted my approval thereon and return the same herewith to you, together with the above mentioned papers.
