**Narrative:**

On Friday, September 26, 2025, Ohio Bureau of Criminal Investigation (BCI) Special Agent (SA) Joe Lamping (SA Lamping) received a "Firearms Trace Summary" report from the Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco, Firearms and Explosives (ATF). The report contained information about the firearm that Jerry Pegram possessed during the incident on September 8, 2025. The report provided details about the Smith & Wesson Governor .45/410 revolver bearing serial number CTB2816, including that it was [REDACTED]
