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Narrative:

On Wednesday June 26, 2024, Ohio Bureau of Criminal (BCI) Special Agent Andrew Harasimchuk (Harasimchuk) began reviewing the following previously requested and received written statements and operational assignments from the Eastside Departments Enforcement Group (EDGE) SWAT team. The written statements and operational assignments involved EDGE SWAT assisting the United States Marshals Services (USMS) with the apprehension of De'Shawn Vaughn (Vaughn) on May 12, 2024. Vaughn was the suspect in a homicide of a Euclid Police Officer. The events that took place on May 12, 2024, led to the officer-involved critical incident that occurred at 16100 Van Aken Boulevard, Shaker Heights, Ohio 44120.

EDGE - Incident Report - Captain Mike Janson

This report that was completed by EDGE SWAT Commander Captain Mike Janson stated the following:

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On 5/12/2024 at 1200 hours, I, Capt. Janson (Euclid PD/ EDGE SWAT Commander) received word that the USMS may have Deshaun Vaughn in an apartment in Shaker Heights. Deshaun Vaughn was wanted for the murder of Euclid Ptl. Jacob Derbin (#14) on 5/11/2024 in Euclid. The USMS had an arrest warrant for Deshaun Vaughn. I sent a message to request that Shaker Heights get their Bearcat to the scene at 16100 Van Aken (#301). I retrieved the EDGE Bearcat and started heading to the scene. The USMS VFTF made contact with a female in apartment #301. She admitted that Vaughn was inside the apartment. Vaughn refused USMS commands to come out of the apartment. USMS inserted 2 robots with cameras and Vaughn was located in the North bedroom. Vaughn took a defensive position laying underneath the bed and pointing a pistol towards the door.

The Shaker Bearcat was on scene at 1300. The EDGE Bearcat and first EDGE operators arrived at 1310. I proceeded to the 3rd floor and met with USMS SSA Lowe. I requested that EDGE SWAT assume command of the barricade operation with the USMS assisting. SSA Lowe agreed and EDGE SWAT took command. I became the overall scene commander, with Carpenter (Asst. Commander/ EPD) and Schultz (Sr. Team Leader/ EPD) as inside command. Carpenter requested that EPD detectives obtain a search warrant for apartment #301. At 1328, shots were fired by the suspect, disabling the Recon Robotics Throwbot. The suspect then fired 4 more shots from inside the apartment. I deployed EDGE Sniper [REDACTED] with [REDACTED] as the spotter/ observer, to the rooftop of 16300 Van Aken. [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] took an overwatch position on the rooftop with a good view of the East windows of Apartment #301. At 1331 hours I issued a "Delta Order" to all EDGE units and it was also relayed to USMS personnel. This order was given to shoot Vaughn if he came into view of any officers on scene.

At 1353, shots were fired by Vaughn towards the rooftop snipers from the North bedroom window. Approximately 6-8 shots were fired by Vaughn. [REDACTED] returned fire into the North bedroom with his Patrol Rifle. Approximately 4 rounds were fired by [REDACTED]. I then had TL O'Connor (EDGE TL/ SEPD LT) remove [REDACTED] from the rooftop after the shooting. I put out a request for all EDGE SWAT members to respond to the scene. I then directed Ciccone (CHPD/ EDGE) to retrieve the 40mm multi-launcher and load it with baton rounds. The north bedroom windows were covered by full length white shades and we could not see inside. Ciccone repeatedly fired baton rounds (foam and wood) through the windows of the north bedroom. Approximately 30-40 baton rounds were fired breaking most of the glass from the windows. The shades were mostly still intact. I advised Ciccone not to launch any OC or CS Gas rounds at this time because we had not cleared all of the neighboring apartments.

We began to formulate a plan to use the windows of apartment #401 to remove the window shades from the north bedroom. Occupants of #401 did not answer the door. It was decided, due to exigent circumstances, that we would breach the door of Apartment #401 to check on the occupants. No one was inside #401 and we entered. A long pole was used to reach down and try to pull the shades from the north bedroom window. After many attempts, only a small section of the middle shade was removed. This provided a view that showed something propped against the windows blocking view into the room.

Carpenter made a plan inside to use the OSHP robot to plant an explosive charge on the North bedroom door. We planned to use a 75GR. rigid linear charge for the door. I was also making a plan to have snipers on the rooftop [REDACTED] - EPD/ EDGE and [REDACTED] - CHPD/ EDGE) deploy sniper rifle fire during the explosive breach. Operators on the ground pilots deployed a drone to the window of the north bedroom but could not see inside. I then requested that they put the drone inside the bedroom through the window. Upon doing so, Vaughn reached up and swatted the drone with his hand. This knocked the drone down and disabled it. This verified that Vaughn was in the bedroom. [REDACTED] would then continuously fire 40MM baton/ CS/ OC rounds into the windows. VEG (Valley Enforcement Group) drone pilots deployed a drone to the window of the north bedroom but could not see inside. I then requested that they put the drone inside the bedroom through the window. Upon doing so, Vaughn reached up and swatted the drone with his hand. This knocked the drone down and disabled it. This verified that Vaughn was in the bedroom.

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At 1620, another drone was sent into the bedroom to verify Vaughn's location again. Vaughn swatted this drone down and disabled it. At 1655 hours, we placed the explosive charge on the bedroom door. Simultaneously with the explosive breach, Snipers alternately fired their rifles into the window of the north bedroom. They fired approximately 20 rounds of .308, combined total. Bertone (BPD/ EDGE) and Ciccone fired approximately 30-40 baton/ CS/ OC into the windows at the same time. This part of the mission was captured on SEPD O'Connor's body cam by [REDACTED]. It was later learned that a USMS TFO from Elyria PD fired 2 rounds into the window from his AR-15 rifle. He fired from the ground up, north of the window at the 1/2 corner of the building. This shooting was not part of the EDGE SWAT plan, it was done without my direction.

Carpenter had the entry door of the apartment breached with shotgun breaching rounds. This was done to remove the door and provide a full view into the apartment. I arrived upstairs and a muffled gunshot was heard from inside the apartment. We deployed the robot (OSHP) to the bedroom and did not see Vaughn inside the bedroom. He had pushed the bed mattress and frame against the window which is what obstructed our view. There was one closed door inside the bedroom and we used the robot to push the door open.

Carpenter and I viewed a face time call from the robot operator at 1750 hours. This showed a person laying on the floor of what turned out to be a bathroom. We could see an outstretched left hand and it was motionless for a few minutes. We used a K9 with a camera to locate the suspect, but the K9 could not get into the bathroom. Entry team consisted of Schultz/ Jasinsky (USMS)/ Imbrogno (UHPD/ EDGE)/ Wilson (SHPD/ EDGE) Selig (EPD/ EDGE), Carpenter (EPD/EDGE). Schultz fired 2 Ferret CS Gas Rounds from the hallway through the wall of the closet that was in front of the bathroom. There was no response from inside the bathroom. The entry team cleared up to the hallway before the bedroom/ bathroom. Wilson deployed a NFDD into the bathroom to see if the suspect responded/ reacted. There was no reaction

by the suspect. Entry team entered the bathroom at 1819 hours and visually confirmed Vaughn was inside. Jasinsky and others dragged Vaughn out of the bathroom and into the bedroom where he was handcuffed by Selig. Vaughn appeared to be dead and was confirmed dead by SWAT medics. Vaughn had a gunshot wound to the head and other blood and wounds to lower extremities. The scene was turned over to SHPD/ EPD/ and Ohio BCI investigators. Ohio BCI became the lead investigators for this case. I was interviewed by Ohio BCI and gave them a synopsis of the events of the mission. SHPD case number for the incident is [REDACTED]. No officers or civilians were injured during this incident.

It should be noted that from the beginning of the barricade situation and until it was resolved, there were continuous attempts to contact Vaughn. USMS/OSP/EDGE personnel in the hallway constantly called out to Vaughn with no response from him. He did communicate sporadically with EDGE crisis negotiators but refused to surrender (see EDGE CNT report detailing their role).

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EDGE - Response to Resistance Reports

On May 12, 2024 at approximately 12:00 I was actively engaged in a USMS investigation attempting to locate De'Shaun VAUGHN who was suspected of murdering a Euclid Police Officer on May 11, 2024. I received information established through our investigation that indicated VAUGHN was located at 16100 Van Aken Boulevard #301, Shaker Heights. USMS personnel responded to the location while EDGE SWAT was activated. Upon arriving at the location, we scouted the apartment to orient our response. We then contained the apartment and knocked at the apartment door. A female identified as Ashley Crenshaw exited the apartment, visibly and verbally fearful. I conducted a tactical interview and confirmed VAUGHN was present inside the apartment. She was unsure if he was armed. A robot was introduced into the apartment to begin gathering further information. A male subject hiding between the bed and wall of the north-most bedroom threw an object on top of the robot, obstructing its view. The robot retreated and maintained visual of the area. While observing the area, a figure could be observed taking various fighting positions ranging from prone below the bed to kneeling/seated over the bed. An additional robot was sent into the room to gather a second view. Upon gaining visual contact through the second robot, the subject fired several rounds from a firearm, damaging and disabling a Recon Robot. The subject then closed and attempted to barricade the bedroom door. At that time, SWAT began arriving on scene and I transitioned into a team leader/liason between the two teams. The first officer I observed was [REDACTED] the EDGE Sniper TL. I immediately ordered him to deploy in an adjacent building to the east and eliminate the threat if he had an opportunity to do so based on the outstanding threat posed. I confirmed for him that the suspect had murdered a police officer, shot a civilian multiple times, posted to Social Media his intentions to fight and cause others serious physical harm, was currently armed and taking up fighting/ambush positions, had discharged the firearm in an occupied residential structure jeopardizing everyone in the area during the current engagement, and refused to acknowledge verbal commands to surrender or speak with police. We then utilized shields as they arrived to harden our position in the hallway. As we strategized to resolve the situation, the subject fired a volley of gunshots through the bedroom window towards the adjacent building where the sniper element had deployed. The sniper's observer returned a volley of gunfire into the apartment. A plastic sheet in the window obscured the snipers' view into the room. Various efforts were made to port the window and unobscure the snipers' view, but they were unsuccessful at defeating the plastic sheet. Drones were introduced through the ported window and were almost immediately attacked and damaged by VAUGHN. One of the drone pilots reported seeing what they believed to be a MAC10 style submachine gun in VAUGHN's possession prior to being rendered inoperable. We then requested that OSHS SRT deploy an explosive breaching charge to the interior bedroom door via iCorp robot. As the charge was placed, two snipers provided slow, deliberate fire into the apartment to prevent VAUGHN from taking control of the charge. The charge was then initiated, removing both bedroom doors from the hinges. The iCorp robot was evacuated from the apartment and the apartment exterior door was removed using ballistic breaching rounds to prevent an obstruction if immediate action was needed. Shortly thereafter, during a period of relative silence, several of us heard what sounded like one, muffled gunshot. Robots were reintroduced into the bedroom and a bathroom door was found to be mostly blocked with what the pilot reported to be a body with blood pooling underneath. Believing VAUGHN was injured, we began making entry into the apartment. We created a shield wall at the entrance of the apartment and deployed a NFDD. No response was received. We then deployed a K9 unit into the bedroom. The K9 alerted at the bathroom door, but could not get through the small gap in the door. I then deployed three 40mm CS barricade rounds through a closet toward the bathroom in an attempt to illicit a response if VAUGHN was taking another ambush position. No response was received and it was later observed that the rounds did not penetrate the bathroom wall. The entry team then pushed to the bedroom, clearing as we went. Before entering the bedroom, PO Wilson deployed a double bang into the bathroom through a small gap between the door and jamb to entice a response should VAUGHN be conducting another ambush. No response was received from VAUGHN. The bedroom was cleared and VAUGHN could be seen laying on the floor behind the bathroom door. DUSM Jasinsky forced the bathroom door open as I provided lethal cover directed towards VAUGHN. VAUGHN was immediately observed to have a traumatic injury to his head with severe blood loss and a handgun was on the floor near his body. VAUGHN was dragged from the bathroom and secured in handcuffs. Medics were notified to begin lifesaving measures. Medics reported that VAUGHN was deceased. I assisted in recovering the damaged drones and robots before exiting the scene.

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<p>On 05/12/24 at 1240 hrs I was notified to respond to 16100 Van Aken Blvd in Shaker Hts regarding a barricaded subject. The USMS had located De'Shaun Vaughn in apartment #301 at this location. Vaughn was wanted in the ambush murder of Euclid Police Officer Jacob Derbin on 05/11/24. There was a warrant for his arrest. Upon my arrival I directed the EDGE Bearcat to the 2/3 corner of the building and moved the equipment van to the same general area. I assumed outside command and directed arriving EDGE personnel. Captain Mike Janson (EPD/EDGE) exited the building and directed me to go inside. I went up the the third floor hallway and assumed inside command. I conferred with TFO Josh Schultz (USMS NOVTF/EPD/EDGE) and other members of USMS NOVTF to include OHSP SRT members assigned to the Task Force. We began to formulate tactical plans and contingencies. While I was in the hallway Vaughn began firing rounds inside the apartment. He also fired rounds out the bedroom window where he was barricaded. Those were fired in the direction of EDGE personnel [REDACTED]/EPD and [REDACTED]/CHPD) who were on the roof of the adjacent building. [REDACTED] returned fire into the bedroom and Vaughn stopped shooting. USMS and EDGE personnel continually called out to Vaughn in an attempt to get him to surrender. He never replied. I directed EPD Detectives to begin drafting a search warrant for the apartment. I also conferred with Janson about checking on the welfare of the occupants of #401 and evacuate them. HHCC attempted to locate a phone number for the residence without success. We eventually decided to breach the door to #401 after not getting an answer. There was no one inside and tactical officers used a pike pole from a window in #401 to attempt to clear out the blinds to the window in #301. Trooper Mike Vitullo (NOVTF/OHSP SRT) advised that they could use their Icor bomb robot to place an explosive charge on the bedroom door to breach the door. We agreed that was the best plan and he made arrangements to get the Icor to the scene. Once it arrived, him and other members of SRT constructed a 75gr rigid linear strip charge. The Icor and explosive charge made it to the third floor. Vitullo stated that they wanted some type of diversion while the robot placed the charge. Janson and I came up with a plan to put sustained 40mm projectiles and .308 rounds into the bedroom Vaughn was in. The charge was placed on the arm of the robot and entered the apartment. When it was nearing the bedroom door, I gave the command to initiate the diversion. Once the charge was in place and the robot was away from the door I gave the command to stop the diversion. The diversion was initiated and there was a positive breach of the bedroom door where Vaughn was located and an adjacent bedroom door. There was an EDGE Recon Scout robot watching door of the bedroom. The Icor was removed from the apartment. Approximately 5-10 minutes after the breach a muffled gunshot was heard from the bedroom. The robot and a drone were placed in the bedroom but did not locate Vaughn. There was a closed door in the bedroom. The Icor was put back in the bedroom and opened the closed door. Vaughn was seen on Icor camera on the floor with blood splatter. He was motionless. Schultz fired to 40mm CS ferret rounds through a closet into the bathroom. There was no response. The entry team cleared the rest of the apartment and approached the bedroom. Steve Wilson (SEPD/EDGE) was able to deploy a NFDD into the bathroom. There was still no response from Vaughn. The bedroom was cleared and Vaughn was dragged from the bathroom and handcuffed. EDGE tactical medics checked Vaughn and found no signs of life. The scene was then turned over to EPD and SHPD Detectives. Nothing further.</p>

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On May 12th 2024, I responded to 16650 Van Aken Blvd Cleveland, OH (Campbell Court Senior apartment) for a SWAT call out for a murder suspect. Upon arrival, I entered the front entrance of the noted address and responded to the third floor. I met with fellow Edge members inside of a laundry room. After several hours, I entered the apartment with SWAT team members. Eventually, I walked out of the apartment and exited to the parking lot.

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On May 12th at approximately 1330 hrs I responded to 16100 Van Aken Blvd in Shaker Hts Ohio for a barricaded male / shots fired at the police. I responded from off duty. Upon arrival I made contact EDGE Team Commander Jansons and EDGE Medics already on scene. While at the scene I assisted with several logistical items including coordinations of EMS personnel, obtaining water for onscene personnel, tools from Shaker Hts F.D. + CVD Drone support. At the end of the incident I confirmed that CEMS would complete an EMS Patient Care Report to document suspect time of death pronouncement. Equipment was returned to appropriate agencies and I left the scene.

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I responded as part of Edge SWAT response to barricaded homicide suspect. Upon arrival I was directed to stage in lobby of 16100 Van Aken. I staged in lobby with Cleveland EMS personnel and medical equipment and developed an evacuation and treatment plan. Upon receiving information that suspect was incapacitated I escorted Cleveland EMS personnel to the apartment. The suspect was determined to be pulseless and apneic with a GSW to the head and various other injuries. Cleveland EMS monitor applied and Asystole confirmed in 3 leads. Provided suspect information to Cleveland EMS medic for pre-hospital care report. Cleared from apartment building.

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I arrived at the incident address and made my way to the EDGE
beacrat. Upon my arrival I stood near the rear of the beacrat
and provided cover for Bertone and Brooks. They were deploying
40mm munitions into the bedroom window of apt. 306. I provided

was finished being deployed I replaced Robbins in the EDGE
beacrat turret until the conclusion of the incident

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I RESPONDED TO THIS SCENE FROM BEACHWOOD FIRE STATION 1. I RESPONDED IN TMA WITH EDGE MEDIC DREW SOISAK. I MADE ENTRY WITH EDGE MEDIC SPISAK, PROCEEDED TO 2-3 CORNER STAIRWELL, ALONG WITH EDGE OPERATORS. MYSELF AND SOISAK WERE STAGED INSIDE STAIRWELL BETWEEN 3RD + 4TH FLOOR. WE STAGED MEDICAL SUPPLIES AND STOOD BY. COORDINATED MEDICAL ACTION PLANS WITH ON SCENE EDGE MEDICS AND EMS SQUADS. NO PERSONNEL INJURIES REPORTED TO MYSELF OR SPISAK. OPERATORS CALLED FOR MEDICS UP TO CHECK ON DOWNED SUBJECT AROUND 19:15. MYSELF, SPISAK, AND EDGE MEDIC JAROS ENTERED APARTMENT AND CONFIRMED SUBJECT WAS PULSELESS + APNEIC WITH INJURIES INCOMPATIBLE WITH LIFE. CLEVELAND EMS TOOK REPORT + CONFIRMED ASYSTOLE. EDGE MEDICS EXITED STRUCTURE.

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On 5/12/24 responded to 16100 Van Aken Blvd for a report of a known suspect barricaded in an apartment & shooting at officers. Upon arrival I was assigned to OSP explosive breaching team & drone team to relay info to the rest of the team. Roughly an hour later, moved to the 3rd floor hallway and remained in the laundry room until team was ready to move in. Moved inside the apartment w/ the team until the suspect was secured by other officers.

Once completed, I remained on perimeter until the conclusion of the roll out.

On the evening of 05/11/2024, I responded to the area of 335 E. 211th St in Euclid for a possible barricaded subject that was believed to have shot a Euclid Police Officer earlier in the evening. I arrived on scene at approximately 2308 hours. Euclid Ptl. John Braun, another member of the EDGE Crisis Negotiation Team, was already on scene. When I approached him, he advised that he was trying to get in contact with the suspect, Deshaun Vaughn, via phone. He asked me to speak with a female that was standing near him in order to get whatever useful information I could that might assist with communicating with and negotiating the surrender of Vaughn. I then began speaking with the female, who was found to be Tania Madden.

Ms Madden told me that her child's father, Deshaun Vaughn, had threatened her earlier in the evening. On numerous occasions she expressed concern for family members still in the residence and told me that she did not believe the suspect was inside. I asked her if she had any idea where he might have gone. She said that she was unsure but said he did have family in the area. Specifically, his Aunt Leslie (unknown last name) and his birth mother Rochelle Ferguson. Ms Madden told me that Leslie raised Mr Vaughn and he referred to her as his mother. Ms Madden told me that Leslie lived in Euclid on "Braeburn" and that Ms Ferguson lived in Painesville.

Ms Madden told me that there were two people that she knew were still in the residence: her grandfather and a 3-year-old autistic child. She said that both were in a second-story bedroom. She believed the child to be asleep and said that her grandfather was physically unable to go down the stairs unassisted.

While I was speaking with Ms Madden, Ptl Braun attempted to call Mr Vaughn at the number that had been provided to him: (216) 924-5114. As phone calls were not answered, Ptl Braun sent multiple text messages. Screenshots of the text messages are attached to this report. The first messages sent by Ptl Braun were at 2334 stating "Desahwn this is John. Are you ok?" and at 2335 "Deshawn please answer me." One response was received stating "Yea wasup" at 2335. Multiple additional messages were sent between that time and 05/12/2024 0101 hrs but no other responses were received. Due to detectives pinging Mr Vaughn's phone, we learned that the phone was believed to have been shut off by that time and therefore further attempts to contact him at that number were ceased.

At one point, I overheard someone talking about Vaughn being in a vehicle and possibly headed to Painesville. I contacted my dispatch (Chagrin Valley Dispatch 3) and asked them to attempt to locate an address for Ms Ferguson. They advised that they did locate a possible address in Painesville. I asked them to contact Painesville PD and see if they could check that location for the vehicle that Vaughn was said to be possibly driving. It was later reported back to me that Painesville PD checked the address and surrounding area but did not locate the vehicle.

Detective Christine Marabito (South Euclid PD) arrived on scene a little bit after me. She stood by in the event that we were able to make contact with Vaughn or if additional sources of information presented themselves.

As information was obtained, it was immediately given to SWAT leadership.

On 05/12/2024 at approximately 1247 hrs, I responded to the SWAT call-out on Van Aken Blvd in Shaker Heights in reference to a barricaded suspect. Deshaun Vaughn, a suspect believed to have been responsible for the murder of Euclid Police Officer Jacob Derbin the previous night was believed to be in an apartment. It was reported that US Marshals were on scene. I was on-duty at the time of the call-out and responded immediately.

On arrival, I was directed to an interior stairwell and up to the third floor. Once there, I found multiple officers standing outside of an apartment. I was advised that the suspect was in the apartment and in a back bedroom. He was believed to be the only person left inside the apartment. I spoke with Det. Josh Schultz (Euclid PD) and he advised me to stand by for the time being until we could make contact with Vaughn. Officer(s) closer to the apartment were yelling inside in an unsuccessful attempt to get Vaughn to speak with us. While we were standing in the hallway/stairwell, robots/drones were sent into the apartment to try to get a visual on Vaughn. One of the robot operators advised that Vaughn had what appeared to be a firearm in his hand. At multiple points, gun shots could be heard coming from inside of the apartment. I was initially unsure as to where the shots were being directed but overheard that it was believed they were possibly directed to the robots/drones.

After some time, I was advised by one of the Marshals that their negotiators that had been outside of the building attempting to make phone contact with Vaughn were getting tired and going to need to be relieved soon. At that time, Detective Christine Marabito (South Euclid PD) was already on scene. I requested to have additional negotiators from the team respond. Sergeant Michael Anderson (Beachwood PD) advised he would respond. I also received a message from Special Agent Julie Yelk (FBI) offering assistance if needed. Around that time, approximately 1515 hours, I was advised by Det. Marabito that friends/family members were reporting that they had been in contact with Vaughn during the standoff and that she would need assistance speaking with them in order to gather information that could be relevant to our negotiation efforts. SWAT Commander Janson (Euclid PD) was advised that I would be accepting the offer from the FBI for assistance. I contacted SA Yelk and advised her that it could be beneficial to have additional negotiators there given the circumstances and that Det. Marabito and I had both been up for much of the previous night on the previous related call-out in Euclid.

After exiting the building and joining Det. Marabito, she spoke briefly with the USMS negotiators who advised that they would be leaving due to fatigue. Det. Marabito and I spoke with an Emmanuel Jackson (DOB 11/26/1986, ph # [REDACTED]) that had arrived on scene. Mr Jackson stated that he was friends with Vaughn and worked out with him regularly. He offered his assistance if needed.

Multiple attempts to contact Vaughn by phone were initially unsuccessful. Det. Marabito texted Vaughn's phone and advised him that Mr Jackson was with us. The following attempt to contact him by phone was successful. During the course of a few subsequent short phone calls, Marabito spoke with Vaughn and encouraged him to surrender peacefully. Jackson told Vaughn that he and other friends would assist him with providing money for a good attorney. During one of the phone calls, Vaughn told Jackson that "E, man, I killed a cop, bro. You know what they going to do to me? I know what they going to do to me" apparently believing that there was no way for him to come out of the situation alive. This was recorded on my body-worn camera at 1617 hrs. He told Jackson to give the money to his children instead.

After those short phone calls with Vaughn, he stopped answering the phone and no further contact was had. Following the final phone call with Vaughn, but before he was found to be deceased, Sgt Anderson, SA Yelk, and two other special agents from the FBI arrived. We stood by, occasionally attempting further communication with Vaughn, until Vaughn was discovered on the floor of the bathroom deceased.

TARGET ADDRESS

On 5/12/2024 at 1200 hours, I, Capt. Janson (Euclid PD/ EDGE SWAT Commander) received word that the USMS may have Deshaun Vaughn in an apartment in Shaker Heights. Deshaun Vaughn was wanted for the murder of Euclid Ptl. Jacob Derbin (#14) on 5/11/2024 in Euclid. The USMS had an arrest warrant for Deshaun Vaughn. I sent a message to request that Shaker Heights get their Bearcat to the scene at 16100 Van Aken (#301). I retrieved the EDGE Bearcat and started heading to the scene. The USMS VFTF made contact with a female in apartment #301. She admitted that Vaughn was inside the apartment. Vaughn refused USMS commands to come out of the apartment. USMS inserted 2 robots with cameras and Vaughn was located in the North bedroom. Vaughn took a defensive position laying underneath the bed and pointing a pistol towards the door.

The Shaker Bearcat was on scene at 1300. The EDGE Bearcat and first EDGE operators arrived at 1310. I proceeded to the 3rd floor and met with USMS SSA Lowe. I requested that EDGE SWAT assume command of the barricade operation with the USMS assisting. SSA Lowe agreed and EDGE SWAT took command. I became the overall scene commander, with Carpenter (Asst. Commander/ EPD) and Schultz (Sr. Team Leader/ EPD) as inside command. Carpenter requested that EPD detectives obtain a search warrant for apartment #301. At 1328, shots were fired by the suspect, disabling the Recon Robotics Throwbot. The suspect then fired 4 more shots from inside the apartment. I deployed EDGE Sniper [REDACTED] with [REDACTED] as the spotter/ observer, to the rooftop of 16300 Van Aken. [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] took an overwatch position on the rooftop with a good view of the East windows of Apartment #301. At 1331 hours I issued a "Delta Order" to all EDGE units and it was also relayed to USMS personnel. This order was given to shoot Vaughn if he came into view of any officers on scene.

At 1353, shots were fired by Vaughn towards the rooftop snipers from the North bedroom window. Approximately 6-8 shots were fired by Vaughn. [REDACTED] returned fire into the North bedroom with his Patrol Rifle. Approximately 4 rounds were fired by [REDACTED]. I then had TL O'Connor (EDGE TL/ SEPD LT) remove [REDACTED] from the rooftop after the shooting. I put out a request for all EDGE SWAT members to respond to the scene. I then directed Ciccone (CHPD/ EDGE) to retrieve the 40mm multi-launcher and load it with baton rounds. The north bedroom windows were covered by full length white shades and we could not see inside. Ciccone repeatedly fired baton rounds (foam and wood) through the windows of the north bedroom. Approximately 30-40 baton rounds were fired breaking most of the glass from the windows. The shades were mostly still intact. I advised Ciccone not to launch any OC or CS Gas rounds at this time because we had not cleared all of the neighboring apartments.

We began to formulate a plan to use the windows of apartment #401 to remove the window shades from the north bedroom. Occupants of #401 did not answer the door. It was decided, due to exigent circumstances, that we would breach the door of Apartment #401 to check on the occupants. No one was inside #401 and we entered. A long pole was used to reach down and try to pull the shades from the north bedroom window. After many attempts, only a small section of the middle shade was removed. This provided a view that showed something propped against the windows blocking view into the room.

Carpenter made a plan inside to use the OSHP robot to plant an explosive charge on the North bedroom door. We planned to use a 75GR. rigid linear charge for the door. I was also making a plan to have snipers on the rooftop ([REDACTED] - EPD/ EDGE and [REDACTED] - CHPD/ EDGE) deploy sniper rifle fire during the explosive breach. Operators on the ground pilots deployed a drone to the window of the north bedroom but could not see inside. I then requested that they put the drone inside the bedroom through the window. Upon doing so, Vaughn reached up and swatted the drone with his hand. This knocked the drone down and disabled it. This verified that Vaughn was in the bedroom. I would then continuously fire 40MM baton/ CS/ OC rounds into the windows. VEG (Valley Enforcement Group) drone pilots deployed a drone to the window of the north bedroom but could not see inside. I then requested that they put the drone inside the bedroom through the window. Upon doing so, Vaughn reached up and swatted the drone with his hand. This knocked the drone down and disabled it. This verified that Vaughn was in the bedroom.

At 1620, another drone was sent into the bedroom to verify Vaughn's location again. Vaughn swatted this drone down and disabled it. At 1655 hours, we placed the explosive charge on the bedroom door. Simultaneously with the explosive breach, Snipers alternately fired their rifles into the window of the north bedroom. They fired approximately 20 rounds of .308, combined total. Bertone (BPD/ EDGE) and Ciccone fired approximately 30-40 baton/ CS/ OC into the windows at the same time. This part of the mission was captured on SEPD O'Connor's body cam by Frato. It was later learned that a USMS TFO from Elyria PD fired 2 rounds into the window from his AR-15 rifle. He fired from the ground up, north of the window at the ½ corner of the building. This shooting was not part of the EDGE SWAT plan, it was done without my direction.

Carpenter had the entry door of the apartment breached with shotgun breaching rounds. This was done to remove the door and provide a full view into the apartment. I arrived upstairs and a muffled gunshot was heard from inside the apartment. We deployed the robot (OSHP) to the bedroom and did not see Vaughn inside the bedroom. He had pushed the bed mattress and frame against the window which is what obstructed our view. There was one closed door inside the bedroom and we used the robot to push the door open.

Carpenter and I viewed a face time call from the robot operator at 1750 hours. This showed a person laying on the floor of what turned out to be a bathroom. We could see an outstretched left hand and it was motionless for a few minutes. We used a K9 with a camera to locate the suspect, but the K9 could not get into the bathroom. Entry team consisted of Schultz/ Jasinsky (USMS)/ Imbrogno (UHPD/ EDGE)/ Wilson (SHPD/ EDGE) Selig (EPD/ EDGE), Carpenter (EPD/EDGE). Schultz fired 2 Ferret CS Gas Rounds from the hallway through the wall of the closet that was in front of the bathroom. There was no response from inside the bathroom. The entry team cleared up to the hallway before the bedroom/ bathroom. Wilson deployed a NFDD into the bathroom to see if the suspect responded/ reacted. There was no reaction by the suspect. Entry team entered the bathroom at 1819 hours and visually confirmed Vaughn was inside. Jasinsky and others dragged Vaughn out of the bathroom and into the bedroom where he was handcuffed by Selig. Vaughn appeared to be dead and was confirmed dead by SWAT medics. Vaughn had a gunshot wound to the head and other blood and wounds to lower extremities. The scene was turned over to SHPD/ EPD/ and Ohio BCI investigators. Ohio BCI became the lead investigators for this case. I was interviewed by Ohio BCI and gave them a synopsis of the events of the mission. SHPD case number for the incident is [REDACTED] No officers or civilians were injured during this incident.

It should be noted that from the beginning of the barricade situation and until it was resolved, there were continuous attempts to contact Vaughn. USMS/OSP/EDGE personnel in the hallway constantly called out to Vaughn with no response from him. He did communicate sporadically with EDGE crisis negotiators but refused to surrender (see EDGE CNT report detailing their role).

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Response to Resistance Report

On May 12, 2024 at approximately 12:00 I was actively engaged in a USMS investigation attempting to locate De'Shaun VAUGHN who was suspected of murdering a Euclid Police Officer on May 11, 2024. I received information established through our investigation that indicated VAUGHN was located at 16100 Van Aken Boulevard #301, Shaker Heights. USMS personnel responded to the location while EDGE SWAT was activated. Upon arriving at the location, we scouted the apartment to orient our response. We then contained the apartment and knocked at the apartment door. A female identified as Ashley Crenshaw exited the apartment, visibly and verbally fearful. I conducted a tactical interview and confirmed VAUGHN was present inside the apartment. She was unsure if he was armed. A robot was introduced into the apartment to begin gathering further information. A male subject hiding between the bed and wall of the north-most bedroom threw an object on top of the robot, obstructing its view. The robot retreated and maintained visual of the area. While observing the area, a figure could be observed taking various fighting positions ranging from prone below the bed to kneeling/seated over the bed. An additional robot was sent into the room to gather a second view. Upon gaining visual contact through the second robot, the subject fired several rounds from a firearm, damaging and disabling a Recon Robot. The subject then closed and attempted to barricade the bedroom door. At that time, SWAT began arriving on scene and I transitioned into a team leader/liason between the two teams. The first officer I observed was [REDACTED] the EDGE Sniper TL. I immediately ordered him to deploy in an adjacent building to the east and eliminate the threat if he had an opportunity to do so based on the outstanding threat posed. I confirmed for him that the suspect had murdered a police officer, shot a civilian multiple times, posted to Social Media his intentions to fight and cause others serious physical harm, was currently armed and taking up fighting/ambush positions, had discharged the firearm in an occupied residential structure jeopardizing everyone in the area during the current engagement, and refused to acknowledge verbal commands to surrender or speak with police. We then utilized shields as they arrived to harden our position in the hallway. As we strategized to resolve the situation, the subject fired a volley of gunshots through the bedroom window towards the adjacent building where the sniper element had deployed. The sniper's observer returned a volley of gunfire into the apartment. A plastic sheet in the window obscured the snipers' view into the room. Various efforts were made to port the window and unobscure the snipers' view, but they were unsuccessful at defeating the plastic sheet. Drones were introduced through the ported window and were almost immediately attacked and damaged by VAUGHN. One of the drone pilots reported seeing what they believed to be a MAC10 style submachine gun in VAUGHN's possession prior to being rendered inoperable. We then requested that OSHP SRT deploy an explosive breaching charge to the interior bedroom door via iCorp robot. As the charge was placed, two snipers provided slow, deliberate fire into the apartment to prevent VAUGHN from taking control of the charge. The charge was then initiated, removing both bedroom doors from the hinges. The iCorp robot was evacuated from the apartment and the apartment exterior door was removed using ballistic breaching rounds to prevent an obstruction if immediate action was needed. Shortly thereafter, during a period of relative silence, several of us heard what sounded like one, muffled gunshot. Robots were reintroduced into the bedroom and a bathroom door was found to be mostly blocked with what the pilot reported to be a body with blood pooling underneath. Believing VAUGHN was injured, we began making entry into the apartment. We created a shield wall at the entrance of the apartment and deployed a NFDD. No response was received. We then deployed a K9 unit into the bedroom. The K9 alerted at the bathroom door, but could not get through the small gap in the door. I then deployed three 40mm CS barricade rounds through a closet toward the bathroom in an attempt to illicit a response if VAUGHN was taking another ambush position. No response was received and it was later observed that the rounds did not penetrate the bathroom wall. The entry team then pushed to the bedroom, clearing as we went. Before entering the bedroom, PO Wilson deployed a double bang into the bathroom through a small gap between the door and jamb to entice a response should VAUGHN be conducting another ambush. No response was received from VAUGHN. The bedroom was cleared and VAUGHN could be seen laying on the floor behind the bathroom door. DUSM Jasinsky forced the bathroom door open as I provided lethal cover directed towards VAUGHN. VAUGHN was immediately observed to have a traumatic injury to his head with severe blood loss and a handgun was on the floor near his body. VAUGHN was dragged from the bathroom and secured in handcuffs. Medics were notified to begin lifesaving measures. Medics reported that VAUGHN was deceased. I assisted in recovering the damaged drones and robots before exiting the scene.

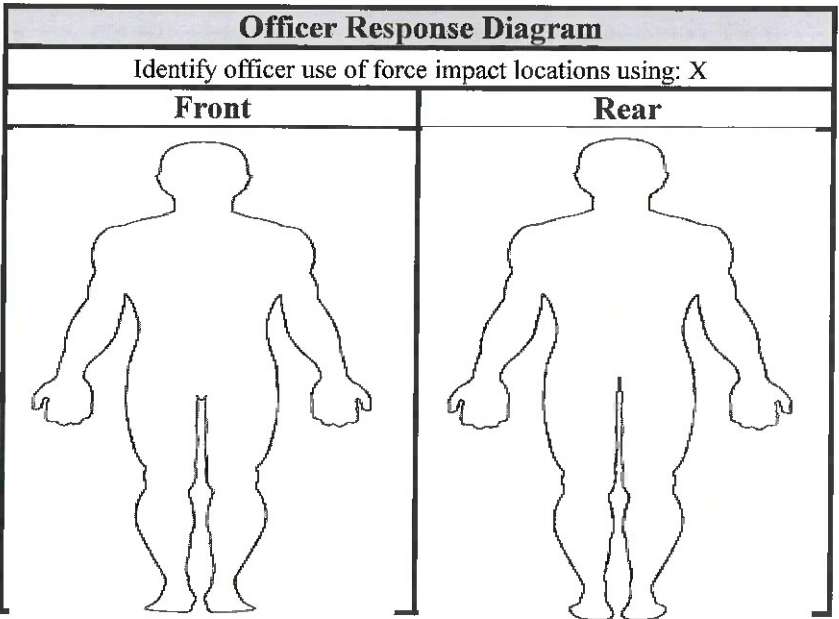

<p>On 05/12/24 at 1240 hrs I was notified to respond to 16100 Van Aken Blvd in Shaker Hts regarding a barricaded subject. The USMS had located De'Shaun Vaughn in apartment #301 at this location. Vaughn was wanted in the ambush murder of Euclid Police Officer Jacob Derbin on 05/11/24. There was a warrant for his arrest. Upon my arrival I directed the EDGE Bearcat to the 2/3 corner of the buling and moved the equipment van to the same general area. I assumed outside command and directed arriving EDGE personnel. Captain Mike Janson (EPD/EDGE) exited the building and directed me to go inside. I went up the the third floor hallway and assumed inside command. I conferred with TFO Josh Schultz (USMS NOVFTF/EPD/EDGE) and other members of USMS NOVFTF to include OHSP SRT members assigned to the Task Force. We began to formulate tactical plans and contingencies. While I was in the hallway Vaughn began firing rounds inside the apartment. He also fired rounds out the bedroom window where he was barricaded. Those were fired in the direction of EDGE personnel (██████/EPD and ██████/CHPD) who were on the roof of the adjacent building. ██████ returned fire into the bedroom and Vaughn stopped shooting. USMS and EDGE personnel continually called out to Vaughn in an attempt to get him to surrender. He never replied. I directed EPD Detectives to begin drafting a search warrant for the apartment. I also conferred with Janson about checking on the welfare of the occupants of #401 and evacuate them. HHCC attemptpted to locate a phone number for the residence without success. We eventually decided to breach the door to #401 after not getting an answer. There was no one inside and tactical officers used a pike pole from a window in #401 to attempt to clear out the blinds to the window in #301. Trooper Mike Vitullo (NOVFTF/OHSP SRT) advised that they could you their Icor bomb robot to place an explosive charge on the bedroom door to breach the door. We agreed that was the best plan and he made arrangements to get the Icor to the scene. Once it arrived, him and other members of SRT constructed a 75gr rigid linear strip charge. The Icor and explosive charge made it to the third floor. Vitullo stated that they wanted some type of diversion while the robot placed the charge. Janson and I came up with a plan to put sustained 40mm projectiles and .308 rounds into the bedroom Vaughn was in. The charge was placed on the arm of the robot and entered the apartment. When it was nearing the bedroom door, I gave the command to initiate the diversion. Once the charge was in place and the robot was away from the door I gave the command to stop the diversion. The was initiated and there was a positive breach of the bedroom door where Vaughn was located and an adjacent bedroom door. There was an EDGE Recon Scout robot watching door of the bedroom. The Icor was removed from the apartment. Approximately 5-10 minutes after the breach, a muffled gunshot was heard from the bedroom. The robot and a drone were placed in the bedroom but did not locate Vaughn. There was a closed door in the bedroom. The Icor was put back in the bedroom and opened the closed door. Vaughn was seen on Icor camera on the floor with blood splatter. He was motionless. Schultz fired to 40mm CS ferret rounds through a closet into the bathroom. There was no response. The entry team cleared the rest of the apartment and approached the bedroom. Steve Wilson (SEPD/EDGE) was able to deploy a NFDD into the bathroom. There was still no response from Vaughn. The bedroom was cleared and Vaughn was dragged from the bathroom and handcuffed. EDGE tactical medics checked Vaughn and found no signs of life. The scene was then turned over to EPD and SHPD Detectives. Nothing further.</p>

When I arrived on scene, I responded to Commander Jankov who assigned me to operate a 40MM less lethal weapon system. Snipers on scene advised that the suspect had lowered blinds to the room he had barricaded himself in, leaving them with no view into the room. It was at this time that I began to fire 40mm impact rounds into the blinds in an attempt to remove them so snipers could have a view into the room & gain a better position. However, it was ineffective at completely removing the blinds. I then took position on the 4th floor of the apartment building. It was here that I continued to standby for the duration of the incident until it was put out over the radio that a team had entered the apartment & found the suspect deceased.

There was no response by the suspect and it was unknown if he was deceased or laying in wait. Once we got into the master bedroom I deployed a CTS Double Banging Distraction Device into the bathroom where the suspect was located in order to get a response from the suspect. With visual observation from the lobby, it was determined there was no reaction and the suspect was most likely deceased. Upon contact with the suspect it was observed that the suspect was deceased from a possible self-inflicted gun shot wound.

On May 12th, 2024, I Sgt. Imbrogno was assigned to the EDGE SWAT team and received a page of a barricade subject located at 16100 Van Aken Blvd, Shaker Heights, Ohio. At approximately 01230 hours I showed up to, assist in the operation. I spent most of my day in the hallway right outside of the barricade subject's location. During the operation, I operated the throw bots for the swat team to keep eyes on the door/room the suspect was located in. After several steps were taken to get the suspect out of the bedroom in the apartment, an entry team was form to make entry. The entry team consist of three Swat members and one USMS member. After entry was made into the apartment, I made entry into bedroom #2, which was a vacant room, filled with storage. Then the entry team made entry into the suspect's bedroom after deploying a flash bang inside the bathroom, where we believed he was in. Once it was verified that the suspect was laying unresponsive on the bathroom floor, the USMS member and myself pulled the suspect out of the bathroom. It was apparent at this time the suspect was DOA. I cleared at 1930 hours.
