**Narrative:**

Ohio Bureau of Criminal Investigation (BCI) Special Agent (SA) Andrew Harasimchuk (Harasimchuk) complied and reviewed background information on Thomas Nock (Nock), a subject involved in the November 4, 2023, officer-involved shooting in North Olmsted, Ohio. The information included researching and reviewing past police reports involving the subject, a computerized criminal history (CCH), court records (if applicable), open/closed-source database inquiries and social media posts. The information gathered was obtained from the BCI Criminal Intelligence Unit (CIU) and SA Harasimchuk.

SA Harasimchuk reviewed the information and noted the following:

Computerized Criminal History:

Per BCI CIU, Nock did not have a prior criminal history.

Prior Law Enforcement Contact:

The North Olmsted Police Department (NOPD) provided all previous encounters the agency had with Nock. The NOPD provided police reports for 14 encounters the agency had with Nock before November 4, 2023. None of the encounters involved [REDACTED]

SA Harasimchuk also reviewed Ohio Law Enforcement Gateway (OHLEG) records and noted that [REDACTED]

North Olmsted Police Department

- **NOPD Incident 1628954** – On September 7, 2016, Nock’s neighbors called police about the smell of marijuana coming from Nock’s apartment. Nock then

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went to talk to the complainant and allegedly accused the complainant of harassing him [Nock].

- **Traffic Crash Report T73646** - On November 4, 2016, Nock was a witness to a traffic accident that occurred in North Olmsted.
- **NOPD Incident 1700160** - On January 2, 2017, Nock went to the police department to speak to a police officer about an ongoing issue with a neighbor.
- **NOPD Incident 1714155** - On May 6, 2017, a male, Arlo Goodwin (Goodwin) reported to police that Nock had punched him [Goodwin].
- **NOPD Incident 1718508** - On June 12, 2017, a neighbor called police to complain that Nock was screaming at the caller's daughter and husband.
- **NOPD Citation N255898s** - On April 2, 2019, Nock received a citation for speeding.
- **NOPD Incident 22101459** - On March 6, 2021, Nock was arrested for felony OVI.
- **NOPD Incident 2119797** - On June 16, 2021, Nock's neighbor called the police stating that Nock was threatening the caller's husband.
- **NOPD Incident 2322453** - On June 14, 2023, police were called because someone had shot a gun or was setting off fireworks. Nock was associated with this incident.
- **NOPD Incident 2322575** - On June 15, 2023, a neighbor called police to report that Nock was fighting with a female.
- **NOPD Incident 2323912** - On June 24, 2023, Nock called the police requesting that the police do a welfare check on Nock's wife.
- **NOPD Report 23-37225** - On September 17, 2023, Nock called the police on a female that Nock was living with. Nock reported that this female was trying to stab Nock's dog. The female was arrested by NOPD for tampering with evidence and drug related offenses.
- **NOPD Incident 2341351** - On October 15, 2023, a neighbor of Nock's called the NOPD to report Nock's odd behavior. The neighbor said that Nock speeds through the neighborhood, blares music and screams.
- **NOPD Incident 2341855** - On October 18, 2023, one of Nock's neighbors called the NOPD to report Nock was playing loud music.
- **NOPD Report [REDACTED]** - This report documents NOPD involvement with Nock on November 4, 2023. This report was reviewed by SA Matthew Armstrong (Armstrong). Refer to SA Armstrong's report titled, *2024-03-12: Review of North Olmsted Police Incident Report* for further details.

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Other Law Enforcement Agencies

- **Euclid Police Department** – On October 30, 2023, Officer Phillip Tschetter (Tschetter) ran Nock in OHLEG. The Euclid Police Department had nothing on file on Nock. SA Harasimchuk spoke with Officer Tschetter. Officer Tschetter stated that he [Officer Tschetter] is in the traffic unit and believes that he [Officer Tschetter] ran Nock in OHLEG due to a traffic violation but then never contacted Nock.
- **Cleveland Division of Police Report 2023-332609** – On October 31, 2023, Nock's brother, Tyler Nock [Tyler] called police and reported that Nock had assaulted him [Tyler] after having a conversation about God. Tyler did not prosecute Nock for this incident.

Social Media:

Per BCI CIU Nock did not have any social media activity.

Database Searches:

An Accurint report was obtained and reviewed. Nothing relevant to the investigation was observed. The documents received relative to Nock are attached to this report for further review, with the exception of any prohibited LEADS/CCH reports, which have been stored or disposed of according to applicable policies and procedures.

CALLER STATES THE NEIGHBORS DOWNSTAIRS ARE SMOKING MARIJUANA AGAIN, CAUSING HER DAUGHTER TO HAVE AN ASTHMA ATTACK. SQUAD OFFERED NUMEROUS TIMES AND REFUSED.  
 --COMPL ADVISED OCCUPANTS OF APT LEFT PRIOR TO ARRIVAL. FAINT SMELL IN HALLWAY, UNABLE TO DETERMINE THE SOURCE. ADVISED TO CALL IF IT HAPPENS AGAIN.  
 --1744HRS COMPL CALLED BACK STATING THE NEIGHBORS BELOW HER JUSTS CAME TO HER DOOR BEING AGGRESSIVE, ACCUSING HER OF HARASSING THEM. WOULD LIKE NOPD TO RETURN.  
 --OFFICERS SPOKE TO NEIGHBOR DOWNSTAIRS (NOCK,THOMAS). HE STATES HE TRIED TO TALK TO COMPL ABOUT THE SITUATION AND SHE SLAMMED THE DOOR IN HIS FACE. HE STATES HE DOES NOT SMOKE MARIJUANA. BOTH PARTIES ADVISED NOT TO HAVE ANY CONTACT WITH EACH OTHER, AND IF THERE'S A PROBLEM TO CONTACT NOPD.

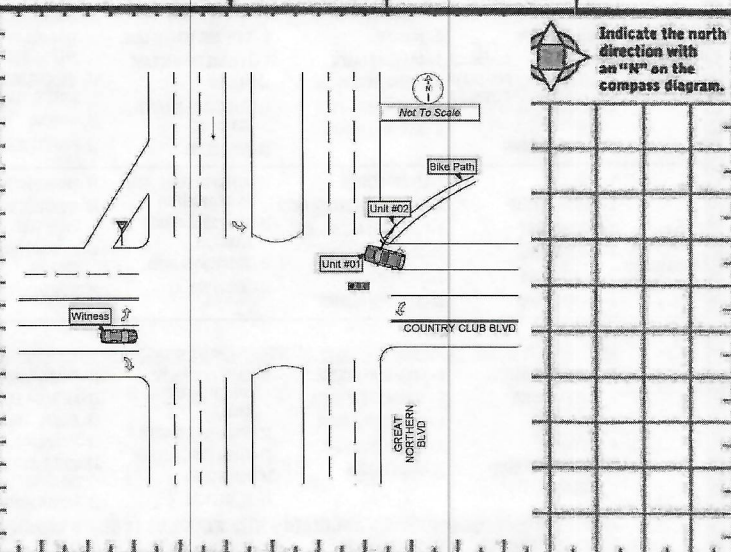

On Sunday, September 17, 2023 at 1802 hours. I responded to 24565 Clareshire Drive Apt. 103 with Ptl. Juergens and Ptl. Pruitt for a possible domestic. During the investigation possible narcotics were located within the residence.

Upon our arrival, both parties for the incident were outside in the common lawn area of 14565 Clareshire Dr. While on scene speaking with Thomas Nock who stated that Angelina Speer was attempting to stab his dog in the woods. Nock was unsure where in the woods they were located, but stated Speer tied his dog to a tree and was attempting to perform some type of satanic ritual on the dog. At no point was the dog harmed during the incident.

I asked Nock what his relationship was to Speer. Nock told me she was a friend who moved in about a month ago, Nock then stated he wants her to vacate the residence. I advised Nock that at this point, Speer is considered a resident due to having personal property at the residence and for being there for an extended amount of time.

While Ptl. Juergens was speaking to Speer, she stated that she has been living with Nock for approximately 1 month and denied the incident took place. Speer said she had a ride to come pick her up and also her property, Speer was moving out with no intentions to come back. Ptl. Juergens and I went to assist Speer with retrieving her property, Speer had multiple bags and other personal property to retrieve from the apartment and was okay with Ptl. Juergens and I assisting her. Ptl. Pruitt remained outside the residence with Nock at this time.

Once at the apartment door of the 24565 Clareshire apt 103, the door was locked. Ptl Juergens asked Nock for the keys to the apartment, in order to assist Speer. Ptl. Juergens unlocked the door to the apartment and once entering the apartment to help Speer retrieve her property, in plain view on the kitchen table was a small mirror with a white powdery substance on it with a cut straw. Next to the mirror, also in plain view was a small vial with more white crystalized substance and a small press style container.

Speer told us that "I should've cleaned that". I advised Speer to continue grabbing her property to start the process of her moving out. I advised Sgt. Gorbulja of my findings, at this time, Sgt. Gorbulja and Ptl. Petrie arrived on scene for ET Photos.

Speer approached the kitchen table where the suspected narcotics were placed. Speer grabbed a small pink plastic container with the white residue in it and attempted to walk away with it. I advised Speer to put it down on the table. Speer then placed the container back on the table. I looked back at the table and noticed the vial with the white crystalized substance missing. I told Speer to come back and open her hand. Inside Speer's left hand was the vial. At this time, Ptl. Petrie and I placed Speer into handcuffs and advised she was being placed under arrest for Tampering with Evidence. Ptl. Petrie advised Speer of her Miranda Warning.

Speer was taken back to NOPD Jail where she was booked and processed. Speer is being held in NOPD Jail until 09-18-2023 when she is seen by a Judge at Rocky River Municipal Court.

On 09/17/2023 at approximately 1834 hours I responded to 24565 Claeshire Drive unit #103.

Prior to me responding, Ptl. Dwulat had contacted Sgt. Gorbulja to advise narcotics were located in the home. Ptl. Dwulat and Ptl. Juergens stated they were assisting the female party, identified as Angelina Speer, with removing her property from the home. Speer advised she had been staying with the male party involved, identified as Thomas Nock, the last month. As soon as Ptl. Dwulat entered the home, he observed the narcotics on the table in plain view.

While she placed the grinder/press down, Speer then quickly grabbed another item, found to be a vial with powder inside it.

At this time, Ptl. Dwulat ordered Speer to hand that over and began to further argue with Ptl. Dwulat about the contraband. I immediately placed Speer into handcuffs and advised she was now under arrest for Tampering with Evidence. I advised Speer her Miranda Warnings which she stated she understood.

Ptl. Juergens escorted Speer out of the residence where she was taken back to NOPD jail to be booked and processed.

I took evidence technician photographs of the contraband and seized the items.

The following items I seized from the table included the following:

Medium sized vial with powder inside it 15.3 net grams

Powder on a mirror 1.2 net grams

## SYNOPSIS OF CASE

Wolcott and a Westlake PD officer went to the west side of the fence where Thomas was lying (backyard of 5219 Berkshire Dr). As the Westlake PD officer utilized a shield, he and Ptl. Wolcott approached Thomas. As other officers and I kept Thomas at gunpoint, Ptl. Wolcott kicked out two fence planks. At this time, Ptl. Wolcott was able to remove the firearm from Thomas' hand and pulled it toward his location. With the firearm away from Thomas, Ptl. Wolcott pushed down a section of the fence and pulled it toward him. Ptl. Wolcott and the Westlake PD officer pulled Thomas to the backyard of 5219 Berkshire Dr. Thomas had blood on his person and part of his jaw was missing. It appeared to officers on scene a bullet traveled through and through to the back of his head. Thomas was secured in handcuffs behind his back by Ptl. Robertson. Ptl. Ashenfelter began chest compressions on Thomas. I took over chest compressions from Ptl. Ashenfelter. Ptl. Robertson later relieved me from doing chest compressions and then a Westlake PD officer continued compressions until NOFD arrived on scene. NOFD continued first aid on Thomas and later transported him to Fairview General Hospital.

After NOFD transported Thomas to the hospital, I began to take photographs of the scene. Photographs were taken of the rifle casings from where [REDACTED] shot rounds in the backyard of 5212 Douglas Dr, the handgun casings from where the Westlake PD officer shot rounds in the backyard of 5230 Douglas Dr, the area where the suspect was lying between the fence and tree in the backyard of 5212 Douglas Dr, and the area where the suspect was moved to in the backyard of 5219 Berkshire Dr. Blood from the suspect was on the ground and on the fence. There were bullet fragments in a tree near where the suspect was lying. Bullet holes were located in the fence where the suspect was up against. Photographs were then taken of the suspect's firearm, knife, bloody hat, bloody glasses, bloody shoe, and phone. Blood was also located from [REDACTED] in the backyard of 5212 Douglas Dr, which was also photographed. BCI arrived on scene a short time later and began photographing the area. The BCI agent later collected all of the evidence before Sgt. Fioritto could scan the area with the FARO machine.

As officers were securing Thomas, NOFD and surrounding fire departments were working to put out the fire at [REDACTED]. Once the house was deemed safe to enter, an unknown deceased male was located inside the residence.

[REDACTED] Wilson and [REDACTED] were at the other residence, on [REDACTED]. They advised on the radio that it appeared the home was on fire, and they heard what they thought was a gunshot.

I then departed Park Ridge Dr. and started heading to [REDACTED]. While en-route [REDACTED] advised a male was fleeing the home, running west through the backyards, towards Berkshire Dr. As I neared the area, I saw several Westlake officers in the front yards of homes on Berkshire Dr. I exited my vehicle in the area of 5219 Berkshire Dr.

[REDACTED] advised he had the male at gun point, and responding officers began trying to determine his whereabouts. A few seconds later I heard a large volume of gunshots coming from the yard area seemingly directly to my east. After the commotion I heard an officer yell that an officer was injured by the gunfire, then heard it broadcast over the radio.

I made my way the area where the confrontation occurred, and was directed to an area behind the fence on the east border of 5219 Berkshire Dr. I could see the head of the subject, later identified as Mr. Thomas Nock. I could see that he was wearing a black ski mask over his face/head, could see his torso, and could see a black semi-automatic handgun in his hands. He was laying with his heading facing south, feet facing north. He was in between a large tree, and an approximately four-foot-tall wooden fence, surrounded by heavy shrubbery/vegetation. I called out to Mr. Nock several times, receiving no response.

Westlake Officer Posante and I then jumped the fence on the south side of the property and began to approach Mr. Nock. Officer Posante was carrying a ballistic shield while I maintained lethal coverage of Mr. Nock. As we neared Mr. Nock, it was apparent that there was no safe way to reach over the fence to secure the firearm. I then kicked out two boards of the fence, allowing me to reach the handgun. Mr. Nock was holding the firearm in both hands, with the barrel facing south-west, towards his head. I retrieved the firearm and set it on the ground on the west side of the fence. Officer Posante and I then tore down a section of fence, and pulled Mr. Nock into the open yard. I then instructed Officers Wilson, Robertson, and Ashenfelter to begin CPR on Mr. Nock, while I radioed dispatch requesting a medic and maintained scene security.

Officers Wilson Robertson and Ashenfelter continued performing CPR until NOFD arrived on scene and took custody of Mr. Nock

When I first approached Mr. Nock, he was wearing khaki colored pants, which were soiled with blood, blue surgical gloves on his hands, and a black ski mask. He had a silver folding knife in his right pants pocket, and was holding a Beretta APX semi-automatic handgun in both of his hands.

By this point [REDACTED] had been transported to St. John's Westshore Hospital by Westlake officers.

I remained at the scene while Westlake and North Olmsted Officers cordoned off the area.

Westlake PD officers remained in a surrounding neighboring home.

I was informed that Mr. Condon was the injured officer that was transported to SMMC and that he had his patrol rifle at the suspect. I was advised by Mr. Westlake that Mr. Condon was shot once in his forearm and once in the chest but that it did not penetrate due to his ballistic vest. I also spoke with Sgt. Lee of Westlake PD and he indicated that WTPD Lt. Long was not injured.

I had Sgt. Donohue respond to the St. John's Medical Center E.R. after Mr. Condon's arrival there with transporting Westlake PD officer Mr. Craig and Mr. Asher. Mr. Asher's role with the NODD squad in Fairview Hospital with the suspect Thomas Noel. I also advised NODD dispatch to start calling in additional NODD officers from other shifts to assist. I also spoke with Captain Morgan, Detective Sgt. Beck, Sgt. Fierstein and Det. Richards regarding the incident.

On 11/4/23 at approximately 03:05 hrs, I responded back to the backyard at 2219 Birkshire Dr. I had been transported. I spoke with Mr. Westlake who informed me that Mr. Asher's sister contacted CPR on Mr. Noel before the squad arrived. I observed blood on the grass, a Beretta handgun and several shell casings on the ground in the backyard near a fence. Assisting police agencies helped contain off the area with crime scene tape at 2219 Birkshire Dr. Mr. Westlake and Mr. Wilson remained in the area to secure the scene. Fairview Park PD and Rocky River PD officers, along with NODD remained at the fire scene on Alden Dr until NODD detectives, Fire Marshall and other NODD officers arrived.

I was advised on 11/4/23 at approximately 03:35 hrs, Rocky River PD officers were checking on a male that was seen walking through the North Olmsted Park from Birkshire Dr. The male was stopped on Lorian Rd. at Tower Center Rd. The male involved was identified as Brian Houston, resident at 28456 Alden Dr. He had injuries and was transported to SMMC with Mr. Asher.

BGI arrived on scene at 04:15 hrs. I remained at the scene until relieved at approximately 07:00 hrs. The scene was turned over to the NODD Detective Bureau and BGI.

On Saturday, November 4th 2023 at 01:39 hours I responded to 2670 Park Ridge Dr. for a report of a bloody male saying someone was trying to kill his uncle at 26725 Alden Dr.

While en route to Park Ridge Dr., radio dispatch advised NPOD that the male was no longer at the address on Park Ridge Dr. and that he began turning in an unknown direction. As I arrived on Park Ridge Dr., I observed the caller's house as being completely dark with no one outside and no one seen turning in the area.

I then began heading to Alden Dr. As I was driving past on Alden Dr. passing Douglas Dr., I heard what I believed to be a gun shot, and observed smoke coming from the roof of the house. I stopped my cruiser two houses west of 26436 Alden Dr. where before exiting my cruiser, I began preparing to deploy my duty issued rifle, when Ptl Condotha advised that he was in foot pursuit, turning WB through backyards towards Backus Dr. I immediately made a U-turn and began driving WB on Alden Dr. towards Backus Dr.

As I approached Douglas Dr., Officer Condotha advised that he had the male at gun point. As I exited the cruiser to begin to detain Ptl Condotha's whereabouts, I heard a volley of gun fire of approximately 150 rounds fired directly north of me in a back yard. I began running NB towards the gun fire, when I heard Ptl Condotha yelling that he was hit. I then yelled out "Where are you at?" As I located Ptl Condotha in the backyard of 26725 Alden Dr., I advised radio dispatch Ptl Condotha was struck in the arm. Two Westlake police officers were with him, where he began turning towards a Westlake police cruiser, advising radio dispatch they would be self transporting Ptl Condotha to St. John Medical Center.

I then made my way to where the exchange of gun fire occurred, where I began asking where the male subject later identified as Thomas Nook was. As I was asked the location of Nook, I took a left turning position along the wooden fence on the west side of the back yard of 26725 Douglas Dr. I observed Nook approximately 30 feet north of me, not moving, lying in between a bush and a tree, with his head facing NB towards me, and his feet facing NB. I was unable to see the rest of Nook's body due to the heavy wooded brush area we were in.

I maintained my position, while Ptl Wolcott and Westlake Officer Ponsante began giving verbal commands to Nook, receiving no response. Ptl Wolcott and Ptl Ponsante began to approach Nook. Ptl Ponsante with a ballistic shield with Ptl Wolcott following behind. Ptl Wolcott advised me and the other officers nearby that Nook was holding a firearm with his finger close to the trigger. Due to Nook lying directly against the wooden fence, Ptl Wolcott began to tear down two boards of the fence to make easier access to Nook so they could secure the firearm.

As Ptl Wolcott was able to secure the firearm, I along with Ptl Wilson, Ptl Astenfelter, and two Westlake police officers advanced forward, where we pulled Nook to near an open area in the backyard, where I handcuffed Nook.

Ptl Wilson, Astenfelter, and myself began performing CPR until Nook arrived on scene. I observed Nook as intently breathing, and heavily bleeding from his head, with half of his jaw missing.

I remained on scene once Nook was transported to Fairview Hospital, where I assisted Ptl Wilson with photographing the scene, as well as maintaining scene security until Ptl H.C. and the NPOD Detective Bureau arrived.
