**Narrative:**

On February 17, 2025, Ohio Bureau of Criminal Investigation (BCI) Special Agent (SA) Jon Lieber (Lieber) responded to the Akron Police Department (APD) located at 217 S. High Street, Akron, OH 44308 as a result of an officer-involved critical incident. SA Lieber met with three involved officers, one witness officer, as well as several members of APD.

SA Lieber photographed the involved officers as well as the weapons utilized during the earlier incident at 294 Ira Avenue, Akron, OH. The following information was noted:
