Narrative:

On Friday, November 17, 2023 at 1200 hours, Ohio Attorney General's – Bureau of Criminal Investigation (BCI) – Special Agent Charlie Snyder (Snyder) arrived at the Cuyahoga County Medical Examiner's Offices (CCME) located at 11001 Cedar Avenue, Cleveland, Ohio 44106. Snyder subsequently meet with CCME Evidence Custodian Astra Driscoll and received the following autopsy/evidence items:

- one large manilla envelope, marked with "IN2023-2006", with labeling "Lab Case Number 2023-008924...", that contained
- eleven smaller manilla envelopes, containing twelve items of recovered evidence indicated as:
 - Item #001 Adhesive stub, gunshot residue, from hands
 - Item #002 Swab from under fingernails right hand
 - Item #003 Swab from under fingernails left hand
 - Item #004 Swabs from knuckles and palm right hand
 - Item #005 Swabs from knuckles and palm left hand
 - Item #006 Swabs from right eye
 - Item #031.01 portion of swab/for release
 - One manilla envelope with markings and containing:
 - Item #032 Reference scalp hair (inside same evidence packaging as Item #033)
 - Item #033 Reference Pubic Hair (inside same evidence packaging as Item #032)
 - Item #034 Projectile whole
 - Item #035 Projectile whole
 - Item #036 Projectile whole

Snyder collected i-phone images of all items and placed them at approximately 1430 hours this date, into BCI Richfield Temporary Evidence Storage locker #3, until items can be submitted into regular evidence.


